Coach National Meet Travel Support Program

Purpose

In its annual budgeting process, New England Swimming allocates funds to help its coaches with the expense of participating in designated USA Swimming National Championship Meets. The National Meet Travel Support Program provides this financial support to help defray the cost of lodging and transportation for its participating coaches.

Coach Reimbursement Requirements

The following criteria must be met for an athlete to be eligible for support:

- If an applicant received, or will receive, travel support from other sources for the designated meet for which they are seeking support, such amounts must be declared on the application and New England Swimming will deduct such funding before support is finalized. If this information is not disclosed on the application, the coach will remain ineligible for funding from this program in the future.
- A coach must be attending the meet with an eligible athlete who competes in at least one individual event.
- The amount of reimbursement is equal to that of one athlete for the designated meet.
- One coach per team for every six (6) athletes attending will be reimbursed.
- All satellites of a club are considered as one club.

Designated Competitions (September 1, 2022 – August 31, 2023)

The designated competitions and support levels were voted by the Board of New England Swimming at its meeting on November 15, 2022. As a reminder, to be considered for support for a designated competition, eligible athletes must compete in one or more individual events. Time trial events, relays or “relay only” athletes are not eligible.

Application Process

- All designated competitions must have an application submitted within 30 days from the last day of competition with all receipts and required documents attached. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
- Support levels listed above are the maximum amount a coach is eligible to receive for that designated competition. Expense receipts submitted (for lodging and transportation costs only) must equal or exceed the amount of requested support for a designated competition.
