NES 14 & UNDER LCM CHAMPIONSHIPS WAS A WEEKEND OF BROKEN RECORDS!

Several old records set in the 1980's and 90's were broken this weekend at the 14 & Under Age Group Championships making for an exciting meet to watch!

Liam Egan, from Crimson Aquatics, walks away with the most records, by setting 5 Individual 13/14 event records:
100 Freestyle NE-RES record: 55.10 (broke the 1994 record set by Stephen Maher of BSC)
200 Freestyle NE-RES record: 1:58.36 (broke the 1997 record set by Nathan Bagnaschi of BGSC)
400 Freestyle NE & NE-RES record: 4:05.69 (broke old records by almost 5 seconds)
800 Freestyle NE record: 8:29.19 (broke the 1984 record of Alex Kostich by 7 seconds)
1500 Freestyle NE & NE-RES record: 16:19.02 (broke the 1984 record of Alex Kostich by 4 seconds)

FOUR swimmers broke the 13-13 200 Backstroke NE RECORD of 2:16.07 set in 2007 by Pat Myers: Shawn Nee from SAC (2:14.81), Ryan Harty from GMSC (2:15.34), and Connor Green from BLUEFISH (2:15.47), but the top prize goes to Robert Owen of CRIMSON AQUATICS with a time of 2:13.79.

RELAYS

The announcer had to stay alert during this meet, because it seemed like almost every relay event broke a record!

- Three teams broke the 13-14 Boys 400 Medley Relay on the last evening of the meet. Crimson and Bluefish gave <u>CHARLES RIVER AQUATICS</u> a great race to the finish. The 13-14 Year Old 400 Medley Relay of Aidan Oi, Christopher Downing, Julian Asuaje-Solon and Dan Goudovitch broke the 16 year old record of 4:23.95 that was set in 1994 by the Mass Bay Marlins, and included Olympic medalist Erik Vendt. It was a great way to end the evening on the last night of the meet!
- <u>BLUEFISH SWIM CLUB</u> racked up a bevy of records in relays: The 11-12 Girl's 400 Medley Relay beat out GMSC's relay for a top NE and NE-RES record breaking finish with a time of 4:50.09, bettering the old records by almost 15 seconds! Angela Foley, Caitlin Murphy, Elizabeth Zeiger and Emma Benkert are responsible for this awesome swim! The BLUEFISH team of Haley Cordery, Emma Benkert, Cailin Murphy, and Elizabeth Zeiger broke the NE and NE-RES record in the 11/12 400 FREE Relay by 3 seconds! The BLUEFISH 13-14 girls weren't to be outdone by their 11-12 teammates and broke a couple records of their own! The 400 Medley Relay of Emma Kao, Brooke Zeiger, Marisa Reidemeister and Abigail Benkert broke the NE and NE-RES record set in 1999 by the MVP. The 800 Free Relay of Abigail Benkert, Ana Maria Castellanos, Emma Kao and Brooke Zeiger broke the 1999 MVP record with a time of 8:52.02.
- **<u>CRIMSON AQUATICS</u>** broke three relay records of their own:

On opening night, the **CRIMSON AQUATICS** 13-14 boys broke the NE & NE RES record in the 800 Free Relay. The team of **Robert Owen, Heson Oh, Brace Young** and **Liam Egan** swam a 8:14.23, beating the old records by 7 seconds!

The 11-12 Boy's 400 Medley Relay of Joseph Turk, Eric Shi, Michael Walsh and Samuel Fromkin beat out BGSC's relay team, and both broke the NE and NE-RES record set in 1989 by the Manchester Swim Club. The CRIM time of 4:56.61 beat the old records, again, by 7 seconds!

The 13-14 Boy's 400 Free Relay broke the 2007 NE and NE-RES record with a time of 3:49.67. Heson Oh, Robert Owen, Brace Young and Liam Egan teamed up again for another win!
