The role of parents is an extension of the parental role in the home. The primary role of the parent is to supply love, recognition, and the encouragement necessary to help your young athlete feel good about themselves. One of the most important things a parent can do is to provide strong emotional support for the swimmer. Swimmers' efforts should be encouraged and complimented as much as possible. Parents should provide the necessities of uniforms, caps, goggles, towels, etc., Parents should also invest their time to ensure a quality existence for the program. It is not the parent's role to coach their child. If your child is receiving criticism from both you and the coach, there is no one there to give them the encouragement and support which is vital in the development of a young athlete. The swimmers should feel safe and supported in their relationship with parents. Parents need to work with the coach to develop this strong, triangular relationship between the coach, parent and athlete. If there is confusion in this relationship and parents try to grapple with the issues themselves without guidance from a coach, some parents can jeopardize a good parent child relationship. Parents should establish a dialogue with their child's coach so that they can build this relationship.


## GRADUATING SENIORS

## **Harry Anderson**



Harry joined CVAC 2 years ago after moving to the School District from New Cumberland. He started swimming at 8 and over his 10 year Club swimming career has qualified for and participated in Middle Atlantic Silver Champs and Junior Olympics. He was the Silver Champs 100 Fly Gold Medalist in 2022, nearly breaking the Meet Record after walking out to "Easy Lover" by Phil Collins. Harry was also a Varsity Letterwinner on the CV High School Teams in both his Junior and Senior Years as well as his Freshman and Sophomore Years at Red Land. He is a multipletime PIAA District III qualifier in events such as the 500 Free and 100 Fly. His primary event at CV has been Fly and could be routinely counted on for Points at every Meet. In addition to Swimming, Harry has been an accomplished Letter-winning High School Track and Field and Cross-Country Athlete. Harry is currently involved in many clubs and organizations, such as National World Language Honor Society (German), CV Pad Project, CV Club Green, as well as CV Mini-Thon. In the Fall, Harry will attend Florida State University to pursue a degree in Marketing with a Minor in German.

#### **Owen Brewer**



Owen graduates as one of the most impressive CV Swimmers to come through the program. He started with the Team in Second Grade and quickly became successful. Early on he was a League Champion, All Star, and Junior Olympic Qualifier. Owen has earned CVAC's coveted Soaring Eagle Award and has held Team Records. As a Senior Swimmer he has qualified for MA Senior Champs and Sectionals. On the High School Team he's been Team Captain, 4 Year Letterwinner, named to the All-Sentinel Boys Team, and his times rank in the Top 10 All Time. Owen has achieved at every level of PIAA competition and has finaled at Mid Penn Conference, District and State Championships. He not only excels in the Pool but is equally talented on the Pitch. An exceptional Soccer player, he went on to lead CV's Varsity Squad to Districts - ultimately setting up a goal in extra time to seal the Title with an epic throw-in - and send the Team to the State Tournament.
