The purpose of this code of conduct is to establish clear and consistent expectations for parent behavior. It serves as a guide to promote a positive team environment and foster good sportsmanship. Additionally, it underscores the importance of respecting the coaching staff and supporting their authority in leading the team.

As a parent, I will follow these guidelines to support a positive team environment:

- ☐ I will set the right example for EAC swimmers by demonstrating sportsmanship and showing respect and common courtesy at all times to team members, coaches, board members, competitors, officials, parents, volunteers, and all facilities.
- ☐ I will show my support and respect for the team and all participants in my words and actions.
- ☐ I understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language or gestures directed toward team members, coaches, board members, competitors, officials, parents, and/or volunteers will not be tolerated.
- ☐ I will refrain from coaching my child from the stands during practices or meets.
- ☐ I will respect the integrity of the officials.
- ☐ I will direct any concerns to the EAC President, EAC Vice President, and/or the head coach.
- ☐ Sexist, racist, homophobic, or otherwise inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
- ☐ I understand the above expectations and that my failure to adhere to them may result in disciplinary action.
