General Criteria

All team members must be registered USA Swimming members at the time of the qualifying performance.

The athlete must be eligible to represent the U.S. in International Competition as of September 1.



General Criteria

Athletes must be 18 or under on September 1.

Roster will be selected according to the FINA database as of early September. If a time is not in the FINA times database, then that time will not be considered.



General Criteria

Relay lead-offs, time trials, swim-offs and intermediate splits will NOT be considered

Long course times will be considered from January 1st, 2017 through and including August 31st, 2017 from all USA Swimming and FINA approved competitions



Performance Criteria

Priority One: Fastest 2 in each Olympic Event

Priority Two: 3rd & 4th in 100 & 200 Free

Priority Three: Additional FEMALES within top 75

& additional MALES in top 100 world rankings



Performance Criteria

Note: A minimum of 26 men and 26 women will be selected. If team size below 26, additional athletes will be added based on highest world ranking.

Once an event has 4 swimmers, it is "closed."



Performance Criteria

Maximum team size is 40 men and 40 women. If more qualify, those with the highest world rankings will be selected.

Should there be a tie, either within individual Olympic event or ranking, athletes' next highest world ranking in Olympic event will be used.

Additional Criteria

Athletes who have competed in an individual Olympic event at The Olympic Games, Pan Pacific Games, or World Championships are not eligible.

Athletes will be considered regardless of year in high school, college or university.



Additional Criteria

Athletes may not appear on the National Junior Team Roster and National Team Roster within the same season.


