USA Swimming

Hershey swimmers ranked Top 25. Three swimmers are currently ranked in their respective age groups for long course meters. The rankings are from September 1, 2005 through May 22, 2006. Meaghan Raab is ranked 4th in the 10&Under girls 50 Butterfly, Katie Nolan is ranked 6th in the 13-14 girls 100 Butterfly, and Alex Barsanti is ranked 24th in the 17-18 100 Breaststroke. Event and individual rankings can be found on the USA Swimming web site.

Where does Hershey rank in the Virtual Club Championships? USA Swimming is currently ranking teams based on their top 2 swimmers in each event with a maximum of 4 events per swimmer. Each swimmer's time receives points and all points are accumulated for total score. Check it out on the USA swimming web site under Virtual Club Championships.

Trident May Maelstrom: The first meet of the season has passed with some good results from first time long course swimmers. Of the 162 swims, 124 of which were first times, 28 were personal best from the veteran swimmers. Meaghan Raab swam to a National Ranking and team record in the 50 Fly, Alex Barsanti swim to 5 time standard improvements along with Peter DeLuce & Felix Nguyen improved in 3 events, and Philip Mancuso, Ian Sherwood, and Mitchell Veith all improved in one event.
