Alex Barsanti, Jacy Dyer, Katie Nolan, and Erica Rapp competed at the Charlotte Ultra Swim Grand Prix Meet that consisted of 16 former Olympians and 26 USA Swimming National Team members. Nolan finished 4th in the 100 Fly behind three former Olympians going 1:02.46, which was just off the Olympic Trial qualifying time of 1:02.39. Barsanti was the only other Hershey swimmer making it back to Finals. She finished 12th in the 100 Breast and 15th in the 200 Breast. The 400 Medley Relay team of Rapp, Barsanti, Nolan, and Dyer finished 14th achieving the Junior National Qualifying Time. Though not all the swims made it back to finals, eleven team records were broken. Nolan (13-14): 100 Fly, 200 Fly ~ 2:23.06, 100 Free ~ 1:01.55, 100 Back ~ 1:08.34, Rapp (15&Over): 50 Free ~ 28.75, Dyer (15&Over): 100 Free ~ 1:01.76, 200 Free ~ 2:13.00, 400 Free ~ 4:34.75, 1500 Free ~ 18:14.39, and the 15&Over 400 Free Relay ~ 4:07.84 and 400 Medley Relay 4:32.68.

Samantha Surfus's 11:05.14 established a new 11-12 800 Free team record and Ian Sherwood's 1:17.77 bettered the 11-12 100 Back team record (Pawlsush 2003).
