Hershey swam against its toughest competition and defeated York Y 478-419. The meet was rolling coaster with there strong 8&unders, our strong 10&Unders and our equally matched 11-12 year olds. The team won the meet but their many over achievers swimming to personal bests in all three swims. Eight & unders Taylor Surfus, Mason Benovy, Matt Ceneviva, Emily Croxall, Kaitlyn Kern, Alex Mitrovic; 9-10 year olds Niki Fistrovic, Saira Kothari, Vivan Tafuto, Sara Gensemer, Isaiah Duck, Madelyn Vieth, and CJ Zachary. Over all the team improved 46% of all swims.

Team Finishes 9th at Middle Atlantic Elite Meet

The Elite meet provides some of the best competition in the Middle Atlantic and surrounding LSCs. Hershey finished 9th out of 50 teams. We had 17 of 32 swimmers medal in the top 8 in their respective events. Leah Sevco led the way with five events. Her highest place came in the 200 Fly by finishing 3rd. Austin Doss, Ian Sherwood, and Tim Maurer each had three final swims. The lone Elite Champion for Hershey was David Nolan in the 200 Backstroke. He also set a 13-14 team record in the 100 Fly (54.97). Also setting team records were Leah Sevco (13-14 200 Back), Katie Nolan (15&O 200 IM), and Kiersten Cooley (15&O 1000 Free).

Nolan Competes at Jr. Pan Pacific Championships



Katie Nolan competed in her first international competition representing Team USA. Junior Pan Pacific Championships took place January 10th through the 14th in Maui, HI. The competition pulled together some of the best 18 and under swimmers representing Australia, New Zealand, China, Japan, Canada, Costa Rica, and Mexico. Nolan swam a full set of events for the week starting with the 100 meter backstroke, which made it back to finals and finished 16th. Her other night swim came in the 100 meter butterfly where she finished 10th. She achieved best times in 4 of 6 events. Many of the swimmers from Team USA attempted the 10K open water swim, but only 4 finished the grueling race. Katie enjoyed the competition and the experience of swimming for Team USA.

HERSHEY RANKED 186TH IN THE COUNTRY

The Hershey Aquatic Club is currently ranked 186th out of 2000+ teams in the USA Swimming Virtual club Championships. Each team is able to have two swimmers per event and age in which each swim is awarded points ranging from 1-1500. A Swimmer may only be represented in a maximum of 4 events. We climbed the team rankings after filling open events and some great swims during the Parkland A/BB/C meet. Within the Middle Atlantic we rank 13th. <u>Junior Olympics</u>: Information is currently available on the MA web site. Entries will be due by February 28th. All USA meets and the WSY and CHY dual meet times are usable. Swimmers are able to enter a maximum of 3 events per day. We would like all swimmers that qualify to attend. High School aged swimmers not competing at the PIAA State Championship should attend. If you are unsure if you will qualify for the state meet, enter JOs. HS swimmers competing at the AAA State Championship should enter JOs for Saturday and Sunday. HS Swimmers competing at the AAA State Championships can swim Sunday (200 back, 100 free, 200 fly, 1650).

- **Lodging:** There are eight rooms reserved at the Residence Inn (Deptford, NJ) for \$133.00 per night. These are all suites with a king bed in one room and a pullout couch in the common area. Each room has a mini kitchen with fridge, microwave, and sink. If you would like to reserve a room, call **1-856-686-9188** and reserve room under Jeanine Surfus.
- **Junior Olympic T-Shirts:** Elaine Mancuso will be putting T-shirt order forms in you folders once we have a good idea of who will be attending. Championship caps will be available.

Eastern Zone All Stars: Applications for the 2007 Eastern Zone All Star meet are available on the Middle Atlantic web site. You must submit an application to be eligible for this meet. MA takes the top two swimmers in each event by age group to form the MA Team. There are typically 8-12 swimmers per age group selected. Event rankings can be found at the USA Swimming web site under Times/Time Standards. Specify LSC, event, and age group.

West Regionals: This meet is directed to swimmers that have times lower than the JO qualifying times. It's an opportunity to gain faster times for the summer meets that require qualifying times. One meet in particular is the BCAT meet in late June. Swimmers are able to swim up to 5 events per day, but I highly recommend that you do not swim more than 4 per day.



Several more swimmers have accomplished the IMX Extreme challenge. Listed below are swimmers, current points, and Middle Atlantic Ranking. IMX scores are part of the selection process for many of your USA Swimming, Zone, and LSC select camps. Most

of these camps use the Long Course season for the qualifying swims.

WSY Valentine 9&Under Meet: All entries have been received. Warm up start at 10:00 a.m. and the meet start time is 11:10. Again, all swimmers will be seated on deck and the parent's will be seated in the stands.

<u>CPAL Divisional Championships:</u> This is the end of the year league championship meet. All five teams in our division come together for one last competition in an attempt to qualify for the CPAL All Star Competition. All meet information can be found at <u>swimcpal.org.</u> The following is important information regarding this meet

- In order to compete, you must have competed in at least **three league dual meets.** Invitational meets do not count toward the three meets. All times entered will be from league dual meets and invitational meets.
- A swimmer may swim a maximum of three events. These events will either be 2 individual and one relay or three individuals. Each team may enter up to two relays per event. All age groups have the Medley and Free Relays.
- This meet will be two sessions. 10 & Under will start at 9:00 a.m. and 11&Over will start 1:00 p.m. Warm up times will be distributed the week of the meet.
- Entry forms will be sent out via email. List the events by priority. Swimmers placed on relays will be taken out of their third event listed.
- Entries Deadline: Wednesday, February 8th.
- All Star Advancement: The five divisional championship meets will be combined. The top 12 individuals and top 6 relays will advance to the All Star meet. This will be available on the CPAL web site under the All Star heading.

<u>CPAL All Stars Championships:</u> All Star information will be available on the CPAL web site. This will be run as the same two sessions as Divisionals. Information regarding the warm up times will be distributed once they are finalized.

How do I know if I qualified? Check the CPAL web site under the All Star information. The psych sheet for All Stars will be posted Saturday evening around 7:00 p.m. Top 12 individuals and top 6 relays swim.
