Because of the limited seating swimmers will not be allowed in the spectator seating area at all. Please be respectful to our Meet Marshals as they are there to make sure everyone remains safe. We ask you to also remember they are parents of swimmers just like you.

Food:

There will be Food Trucks on site for your refreshment pleasure at this year's meet. There will also be a concession area as well. Tickets for concessions will be sold at the front desk. Card and cash can be used to buy tickets but cash payments must be exact. We just ask that you do not bring food into the pool area.

Fine Designs:

Fine Designs will be set up with event shirts and sweatshirts for sale.

Pool Deck and Locker Rooms:

Due to these being a Championship meet the pool deck is restricted to swimmers, coaches, timers and other meet staff only. Parents are not permitted on deck in either the competition pool or warm-up pool. Also for the safety of our swimmers the locker rooms are also restricted to meet Safe Sport standards.
