# **COVID Policy and Practice Schedule**

COVID regulations are changing faster than the weather in Colorado these days. Whether we at Level Blue, Green, Clear, or Rainbow this summer, the safety of our swimmers, coaches, families, and community are our priority. We will be following these COVID guidelines for our practices this season.

 The pool, the pool deck, and its surrounding area will be limited in capacity. For practices, we will allow up to 50 swimmers per practice time. If we have more than 50 swimmers at any one given practice, we will try to move swimmer to the next practice time or may have to revert to a sign-up process (such as signupgenius) for each practice.

- Swimmers must arrive and leave each swim practice in their swimsuit. There will be no use of changing room/showers except to use the restroom.
- Only swimmers and coaches are allowed within the gated area of the pool during practice. Parents will need to remain outside of the pool area. Volunteer opportunities will be available during each practice time for parents who would like to be close at hand. We ask that these opportunities be kept open for parents of younger swimmers.
- Bring your own, properly labeled water bottle (already filled). Drinking fountains will not be available. We also encourage all swimmers to have their own fins and kick boards. (Swim 'n Things offers 15% off for Shark families.) Swimmers cannot share caps, goggles, towels, water bottles, food or other personal belongings with other swimmers.
- All personal belongings need to be labeled with swimmers' name and kept in one spot during practice.
- At this time, swimmers will not have to wear a mask during outdoor training. We ask that swimmers and families wear mask upon arrival and departure of the pool area.
- If any swimmer has a fever or symptoms of illnesses, they may not attend practice until 72 hours after the fever or other symptoms has ceased.

Our practice schedule looks a little different this season. The main reason for the change is to reduce congestion between practice groups. There is also a separate schedule for our first week of practice since most swimmers will still be in school. Preseason is still to be determined based on weather.

The Stroke and Turn Judge positions are essential to running a fair and clean meet. The process of becoming a certified official is simple. You will need to attend an in-depth 2-hour training session (schedule to be announced), where you will use videos to help teach what to look for in a swimmer's stroke.

If you have already received Stroke and Turn certification, we highly encourage you to continue your training in Referee and Starter certification.
