## **Upcoming Meet Info**



New swim families, feel free to check out our <u>Swim Meet 101</u> to help navigate the season smoothly.

- November 1 & 2: MLA Fall Invite Holland Aquatic Center
  - We have been unable to get a hotel block, but several families have booked rooms at the Courtyard Marriott downtown. This venue has lots of seating with concessions on-site.
- November 8 & 9: Atlantis Fall Quack-Tack-Ular Seaholm High School
  - If you are able, we are still in need of a few more volunteers during the meet (<u>sign up here</u>) particularly timers & safety helpers for afternoon and finals sessions. No experience necessary
    - \*Reminder that every family is required to perform at least one volunteer shift at some point during the short-course season (Sept Mar).
    - We will have forms available for any high school or middle school students volunteering who need community service hours.
  - o Our fantastic meet committee is planning a great assortment of concessions for purchase
  - NEW this year, we will be accepting Venmo (@BBASwimming) along with cash for admissions, concessions, and heat sheets

- December 6 & 7: GPG Fast & Furious Grosse Pointe South High School
  - There is limited seating at this venue. It is **NOT** a good meet to bring additional spectators! Last year it was **VERY** crowded and very warm.
    - Tip: Wear layers & bring a neck fan if you have one!
  - There is limited convenient parking at this location. It is best to come early if you want a decent parking spot. There is parking in various locations around the high school, but you might have to walk a bit.
    - Tip: Do not park at the library next door!
- December 10 13: Speedo Winter Juniors IU Natatorium, Indianapolis, IN
  - This meet is a <u>Junior National Championship</u> meet that only a few of our elite Senior swimmers qualify to attend. Check out the <u>USA Swimming Network</u> to livestream the event and cheer our swimmers on.
- January 23 25: Circle City Classic <u>IU Natatorium, Indianapolis, IN</u>
  - Swimmers qualify for this meet based on achieving <u>"BB" time standards</u>. Please review the most current <u>time standards</u> (USA Motivational SCY times) to understand qualifications.
  - Due to other youth sports events, many hotel blocks in the city are full. There are currently rooms available at the following hotels where other Atlantis families have booked rooms <u>Towne Place</u>
     <u>Suites Downtown</u> or <u>Tru by Hilton Indianapolis Downtown</u> (located next door to each other).
     These are only suggestions and by no means mandatory.

Key items to focus on this month

#### Atlantis Fall Quack-Tack-Ular: 12 & Under Prelims & Finals - What Does That Mean?

- Morning Sessions (Prelims): Warm-up at 8:00 AM, meet begins at 9:00 AM
  - o On Saturday and Sunday mornings, swimmers aged 12 & under will swim.
  - Events are divided into 8 & Under, 10 & Under, and 11–12 age groups.
    - 8 & Under events listed as 25s are 'timed finals' meaning they swim in the AM session only.
  - For 10 & Under & 11-12 yr old events, the **top 16** in each event will qualify to swim again in FINALS that same evening.
- Afternoon Sessions: 13 & Over/Open Timed Finals: Warm-ups start 15 minutes after the conclusion of the prior session, but not before 12:30 PM. The meet will not start before 1:30 PM.
  - o These events are Timed Finals ONLY all swimmers will swim the event only once.
- **Evening Sessions (Finals):** Warm-up begins 15 minutes after the afternoon session ends, but not before 4:00 PM. Finals begin no earlier than 5:00 PM.
  - The Top 8 swimmers in each event will race for medals. Swimmers placed 9<sup>th</sup> 16<sup>th</sup> will swim for ribbons.
- **Important!** Scratching Finals: If your swimmer qualifies for Finals but cannot return, they must "scratch" (officially decline their spot) and let their coaches know.
  - Swimmers have 30 minutes after results are posted/announced to scratch this will happen THROUGHOUT the morning session. Be sure your swimmer knows if they need to scratch for finals. They will need to communicate that with coaches and scratch themselves from finals.
  - o Scratches are done at the table in front of the pool office on deck.

#### • Between Sessions

Swimmers who qualify for Finals should head home or find a quiet place to rest, refuel, and stay
hydrated during the break, so they're ready to race their best in the evening!

#### **October Meet Billing**

• If your swimmer participated in the RS Back to the Pool Meet or the OLY Fall Classic during October, you will see charges for that meet on your November 1 bill from Atlantis.

- Specific costs by meet are based upon the charges we incur from the host team (as laid out in the meet packet) along with a \$25/swimmer cost from Atlantis to help cover the costs of coaching and travel
- You can view your billing information at any time by logging into Sports Engine, clicking on "My Account", then "Billing Summary."
