MEET INFORMATION: New swim families feel free to check out our **Swim Meet 101** to help navigate the season smoothly.

Be on the lookout in early October for our volunteer sign-up for the upcoming hosted meet taking place November 8 & 9 at Seaholm High School. Job sign-ups can be found under the meet listing in Events – look for "JOB SIGN-UP". Meets run best when everyone pitches in!

*Reminder that every family is required to volunteer for one shift at some point during the season - our hosted meet is the best way to fulfill this requirement!

Below is some helpful information for our upcoming meets:

- October 11: Back to Pool Meet <u>Lake Orion High School</u>
 - o There is average seating at this venue. There is room for camping chairs along the top. This meet typically has concessions on site.

- Plenty of parking is available at this location. There are lots in front and behind the school. Look for the "Natatorium" entrance and there will be a sign labeled "Pool/Gym" by the doors towards the north end of the parking lot.
- October 18 & 19: OLY Fall Classic Oakland University Natatorium
 - There is PLENTY of bench seating at this venue. There are typically concessions at this venue, but it is a bit of a hike to the upper floor of the facility.
 - Parking is questionable depending what is happening on campus. There are surface lots next to the pool and a parking structure with a bit of a walk. Swimmers & spectators can enter in the "VIP Entrance" along the alley on the northwest side of the Aquatic Center.
- November 1 & 2: MLA Fall Invite Holland Aquatic Center
 - We have been unable to get a hotel block, but several people have booked rooms at the Courtyard Marriott downtown. This venue has lots of seating with concessions on site.
- January 23 25: Circle City Classic IU Natatorium, Indianapolis, Indiana
 - Swimmers qualify for this meet based on achieving <u>"BB" time standards</u>. Please review the most current time standards (SCY times) to understand qualifications.
 - Due to other youth sports events, many hotel blocks in the city are full. There are currently rooms available at Atlantis suggested hotels <u>Towne Place Suites Downtown</u> or <u>Tru by Hilton</u>
 <u>Indianapolis Downtown</u> (located next door to each other). These are just suggestions for families & are by no means mandatory.

New Assistant Coaches - We're excited to welcome some new faces to our pool decks! Please join us in giving them a warm welcome.

- Jason Austermann Jason is one of our TWEAK technique coaches who has crossed over to help our swimmers in the pool. A former distance swimmer, he understands that strong technique is the foundation of great performance. Jason graduated from Michigan State University, where he captained the Men's Swim Team and competed at the 2010 and 2011 Big Ten Championships. He also serves as an assistant coach at HWAC during the summer and has experience working with competitive swimmers of all ages. Jason is currently a science teacher at Berkley High School.
- Jonah Venos A Bloomfield Hills native, Jonah holds a bachelor's degree in Psychology with a minor in Philosophy from John Carroll University. His coaching experience includes time with the Solon Stars/North Coast Aquatic Team in Solon, Ohio, several years as an assistant coach at Beachwood Recreation Association in Troy, and summer work with the Cranbrook Swim Club. As an athlete, Venos was a standout swimmer. At Brother Rice High School, he was a two-time state champion, four-time All-American, seven-time all-state honoree, and four-time county champion. At John Carroll, he built on that success as an 11-time All-American and 17-time Ohio Athletic Conference (OAC) champion. In 2022, he was named OAC Swimmer of the Year, winning the 100-yard breaststroke, two titles in the 200-yard breaststroke, and contributing to a championship in the 800-yard freestyle relay, while setting five school records along the way.
- **Erin Marshall** Erin grew up swimming for BBA, Bloomfield Hills High School, and SURF, where she has also been coaching for the past five years. She is a graduate of Grand Valley State University with a degree in Lower Elementary Education. While at GVSU, she swam with the Grand Valley Swim Club and served as president and workout coordinator. Her favorite event was the 200 butterfly. During her college years, Erin also coached with JAWS in the Grand Rapids area. She currently teaches in the Bloomfield Hills School District.
