PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

4. I will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, spectators, and officials.
5. I will teach my child that doing ones best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of his/her performance.
6. I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during swim meets and practices
7. I understand that my volunteer efforts are an integral part of the success of the team and I will complete my volunteer responsibilities.
8. I will inform the coach of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or the safety of others.
9. During competitions, questions or concerns regarding decisions made by meet officials are directed to a member of our coaching staff. Parents address officials via the coaching staff only.
10. I agree to provide my child with sensible nutrition before and immediately following practice. I understand that swimmers have special carbohydrate and calorie intake needs. Soda, sugar and foods high in fat are not the best choices for a swimmer.
11. As a parent, I understand that only the swimmers are permitted in the locker rooms during swim practice and meets. All others must stay in the provided areas to watch and wait.
12. Should I conduct myself in such a way that bring discredit or discord to the swim club, I voluntarily subject myself to disciplinary action.
