CALL TO ORDER: Acting General Chair Katy Dean called the meeting to order at 6:02pm. Since Secretary Robert Bouchey was absent, Acting General Chair Dean appointed Vice-Chair Administration, Bill Case to serve as Acting Secretary for the purpose of keeping and publishing Minutes of the meeting.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Secretary Robert Bouchey failed to provide Minutes from the February 12, 2014 meeting.

OLD BUSINESS: None

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Approval of the Long Course Schedule

Vice-Chair Program Operations Damon Robertson was absent from the meeting, and failed to designate any other individual to represent him. As a result, the only other member of the Meet Scheduling Committee present was Vice-Chair Program Development Joe McBratney, who was provided the Long

Course Skeleton Schedule only three days prior to this meeting. Senior Coaches Representative Erika Zurcher offered to answer questions to the best of her ability.

The proposed Long Course Schedule was provided to the Board of Directors on Friday, March 28, 2014, and is **attached hereto as Exhibit 1**.

There was considerable discussion about the designation of a "AB Limited C" format for most of the LCM meets on the proposed schedule. Representative Zurcher explained that in such a format, athletes age 12 and under could swim all of the 50-meter events, and that athletes age 13 and over could swim all 100-meter events, plus the 50 Freestyle event. She further explained that the intent was to make sure that athletes with AB cuts were not closed-out of meets due to the large number of swimmers with C cuts who attended meets.

Treasurer Mary Perczak expressed the concerns relayed by her club (SLA), that such a format 1) conflicted with USA Swimming's IMX program, since some athletes could not swim some events, and 2) it was discriminatory to some athletes.

It was suggested that a compromise be met where the meets would be allowed an ABC format, but that entries be limited to no more than 3 per day, per athlete.

MOTION by Dan Meconis to Amend the Long Course Schedule as presented to replace all instances of "AB Limited C" format with "ABC" format, and specify that individual athlete event entries are limited to three (3) per day except as otherwise provided. In addition, provide that clubs may accept deck entries to fill their Sessions, so long as they cost the same price as the normal entry fee, and so long as no swimmer may exceed a total of five (5) events per day. Finally, provide that starting 72 hours after the start of meet entry acceptance, Meet Hosts may contact clubs already entered into the meet and increase their entries to fill available Sessions.

SECOND: Joe McBratney

Motion passed unanimously.

Troy Emmons from MLA reported that he had contacted Damon Robertson and advised Mr. Robertson that MLA was willing to host the 14 & Under State Championship meet if another club was willing to host the Open State Championship. Mr. Robertson failed to report this to his Committee or to the Board of Directors.

Officials Chair Dawn Gurley suggested that the Meet Scheduling Committee contact PCC (who originally bid on the 14 & Under State Championship Meet) to see if they were interested in switching to host the Open State Championship Meet instead.

MOTION by Erika Zurcher to Accept the Long Course Schedule as Amended [attached hereto as Exhibit 2.] with the exception of the 14 & Under State Championship and the Open State Championship meets. PCC would have first right of refusal of the 14 & Under State Championship if they were the first original bidders.

SECOND: Joe McBratney

Motion passed unanimously.

REPORT OF OFFICERS:

A. Acting General Chair – Katy Dean

Based upon a question from Representative Zuercher, Acting General Chair Dean explained the process she followed in appointing Bill Case as Vice-Chair Administration.

Based upon a question from Junior Coaches Representative Vince Gallant, Acting General Chair Dean reported that she had not seen any Petition regarding a request for a Special House of Delegates Meeting.

B. Secretary – Robert Bouchey

Absent; No Report.

C. Treasurer – Mary Perczak

No updated Financial Report. Treasurer Perczak reported that the District and Junior Olympic meet pro-rata payments were complete.

C. Board of Review – Robert Bouchey

Absent; No Report.

D. Coach Division – Erica Zuercher

Ms. Zuercher mentioned that she had submitted a Petition for a Special Meeting of the House of Delegates for the purpose of electing a General Chair of Michigan Swimming.

Based upon a question from Mr. Gallant, Ms. Katy Dean explained that she had no knowledge of such a Petition.

Ms. Zuercher explained that she had sent a Petition to Ms. Jan Cartmill at the Office of Michigan Swimming, but that she would send it to the full Board of Directors in addition.

E. Finance – Dan Meconis

Mr. Meconis reported a projection of \$5,000 - \$6,000 revenue for the Fiscal Year as of the end of March, 2014.

Mr. Meconis expressed his opinion that Michigan Swimming should examine policy regarding Athlete and Officials Reimbursement for travel, since he believes current policy to be inconsistent and illogical. Ms. Zuercher, Mr. Gallant, and Mr. Proctor agreed to work with Mr. Meconis to draft the Athlete portion of a proposal for future discussion with the Board of Directors and House of Delegates.

F. Program Development – Joe McBratnie

Mr. McBratnie reported that he will work on time standards in the near future.

G. Disability Swimming – John Loria

Mr. Loria reported that the 11th Annual Cincinnati Disability Meet takes place May 17-18, 2014 at the University of Cincinnati. In addition, the 7th Down Syndrome World Championships take place in Morelia, Mexico from November 7-15, 2014.

H. Program Operations – Damon Robertson

Absent; No Report.

I. Diversity – Geneen Bradley

Ms. Bradley reported that the Diversity Committee will run a camp in Grand Rapids, Michigan on May 3, 2014. In addition, the committee will send two athletes to the Zone Conference on June 7, 2014. Applications for both events will be posted to the Michigan Swimming website soon.

Ms. Bradley also reported that Portage Aquatics requested a grant of approximately \$5,000 to start a swim camp. Based on budget considerations, the committee awarded a grant in the amount of \$2,000. The camp should start shortly.

REPORT OF COMMITTEES / COORDINATORS:

A. Officials – Dawn Gurley

Ms. Gurley reported that the Short Course Championship Meets were successful.

Ms. Gurley also reported that with the approval of the Long Course Schedule, she will now schedule several Officials' Clinics regarding Relay Takeoffs and other topics.

B. Safe Sport – Adam Hopkins

Absent; No Report.

C. Open Water – Vacant

Mr. McBratney reported that his swim club (KAW) was contacted by individuals in Traverse City, Michigan about the possibility of hosting an Open Water Meet in Traverse Bay, perhaps in August, 2014. Mr. McBratney will provide additional details in the future.

D. NTV – Damon Robertson

Absent; No Report.

MICHIGAN SWIM OFFICE:

A. Registration / Membership / Athlete Records / Clubs – Jan Cartmill

Ms. Cartmill submitted and reviewed her March 31, 2014 Report, **attached hereto as Exhibit 3.**

MOTION by Erika Zurcher to permit the Tecumseh Tigersharks Swim Club to use the Michigan Swimming logo on their team logo banner, as shown in Ms. Cartmill's Report.

SECOND: Mary Perczak

Motion passed unanimously.

B. Meet Sanctions / Meet Results / Times – John Loria

Mr. Loria submitted and reviewed his Report, **attached hereto as Exhibit 4**. Mr. Loria explained the negative impact of many Meet Packets and Requests for Sanction submitted late, particularly to timely processing and compliance with rules.

There was general discussion about the need to enforce the rules and consider penalties for non-compliance, perhaps including late fees.

Ms. Zurcher asked if teams hosting Long Course meets in May, 2014 could be given priority for sanctioning, given the late approval of the Long Course Schedule. Mr. Loria indicated that they would receive such priority.

Mr. Loria will research and recommend a procedure, guidelines and potential penalties for the Board of Directors to consider.

There was general discussion about the pending Short Course Skeleton Schedule and the May 1, 2014 deadline to release for bids. Many people expressed concern about the ability to meet the deadline, particularly given the lack of communication thus far from Program Operations. Ms. Katie Dean expressed the need for regular reports from Program Operations to keep the Board of Directors aware of progress.

Mr. Loria reminded the Board of a commitment from January 2014 for all Officers to review sections of the Rules and Procedures for which they had oversight. Ms. Perczak and Ms. Gurley mentioned that they are making progress. Mr. Loria further noted that when migrating Minutes from prior Board of Directors and House of Delegates Meetings to the new website, he discovered that some amendments / changes were not reflected in the published Rules and Procedures, or were reflected inaccurately. Mr. Case stated that he would investigate this and report back to the Board of Directors. Mr. Case also requested that any individuals with proposed updates to the Rules and Procedures send them to him.

NEXT REGULAR BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING: The next Regular Meeting of the Michigan Swimming Board of Directors will take place on Sunday, May 4, 2014, at a time and location to be determined.

OTHER ITEMS:

- Use of MS Logo on Team Banner: The Tecumseh Tigersharks have requested approval to use the MS Modified Logo on their team banner. They have received approval from USA Swimming to use the USA Swimming logo. I did a little searching and found the following statement in the MS Rules and Procedures:

MS Modified Logo

Michigan Swimming has the right to use a modification of the USA Swimming logo, bearing within it the USA Swimming logo and utilizing the official name of the LSC. The Michigan Swimming modified logo is illustrated on the front cover of this manual. "Slick copies" of this logo are available from the Marketing Coordinator. The modified logo

may be used by MS for stationery, banners, awards, and similar items. The modified logo may not be used on products relating to alcohol or tobacco or on products defined as “technical” swimming equipment (e.g., swimsuits, goggles, kick boards, hand paddles). Reproduction colors for the modified logo are restricted to black, blue, red, white, gold, and silver. **Clubs must obtain permission from the MS Board of Directors before using the MS modified logo.**

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MS 2013-14 Short Course Sanctioning Report

The following is a report concerning the fall short course sanctioning process. The Rule below is directly copied from the Michigan LSC Rules and Procedures pages 72 and 73.

THE SANCTIONING/APPROVAL PROCESS

A. After the meet contract has been returned to the Program Operations Vice-Chair and at least 60 days prior to the actual date of the awarded meet the Meet Host is required to submit to the MS Office Administrative Operations Coordinator a copy of a proposed meet announcement (originally authored by the Meet Host) (see Appendix 3 for the Meet Announcement Template). Failure to submit the Meet Announcement at least 60 days prior to the actual date of the meet may result in the loss of the awarded meet in the Meet Scheduling Committees' discretion.

B. The meet announcement must be submitted to the MS Office Meet and Sanctioning Chair using the MS template as outlined in the Rules and Procedures of MS Swimming. It is preferred that the meet announcement be emailed/submitted in electronic form to the MS Office Meet and Sanctioning Chair in *.doc (MS Word) or *.pdf (Adobe Acrobat) format. A copy of the Meet Manager database should also be submitted to the MS Office Meet and Sanctioning Chair at this time.

Analysis

As you can see on the accompanying 2013-14 Meet Sanctioning Report document, of the thirty eight non championship meets that were on the published schedule only ten of the meets met the submission date requirement as stated in Michigan Swimming Rules and Procedures. Of the 28 meets on the published schedule that were submitted late, they were on average over 17 and a half days late.

It is obvious that the sanctioning process is broken but not for the reasons that many are saying. Unless the Meet Hosts start to submit their required files on time and Program Ops does a better job having the Championship Meet documents ready in a timely manner, this LSC will continue to have the meet issues it has experienced this year.

During the short course season the sanctioning of these meets was not the only duty of this side of the Office. In addition, off the published scheduled meets were sanctioned (including dual, tri, and closed invitationals), Approved and Observed Meets were processed, premeet recons, post meet recons, meet results were processed, results were uploaded into SWIMS, result files were sent out, a new website was built, forms were updated, emails and phone call inquiries were handled on a daily basis, and requests from coaches and parents to look into result accuracy were handled; these were just some of the many duties performed.
