General Chair's Report for BoD July 13, 2015

1. First, I want to acknowledge and offer my appreciation on behalf of all of Michigan Swimming to Program Operations and the Technical Planning Committee for recent cohesive and devoted efforts to assist the LSC with being able to offer the highest quality Championship meets possible, working through challenging issues such as large volumes of athletes, time standards, pool venues, etc. They are engaging in critical thinking and planning that will move the LSC forward. That being said, I need to address a recent bump in the road, with concerned parents, Board Presidents and coaches all communicating with me directly recently in regards to "rumor" of removal of the 10 and Under 400 Free and the 11-12 400 IM events from the upcoming LC Championship event.

The Board most certainly did give Program Operations and Technical Planning Committee a unanimous vote of confidence recently with passing of a "friendly amendment" to a motion to make some minor changes to the approved LC meet schedule. This vote took place just prior to the last HoD meeting and basically approved minor changes to the approved and published schedule being allowable without a Board vote, as this saves time and allows our membership to be informed of these minor changes in a more timely fashion.

This "friendly amendment" did not include major changes to meet formats without Board approval. While many may have anticipated the generic concept of aligning the 14 and Under State meet with Zones as recommended by Technical Planning, it would seem it was not clear to all that the strictest interpretation of this move would be the removal of these two events. Michigan Swimming at this time is required by our R & P to provide for these events. To be clear here, each person that emailed said basically the same thing in closing their message to me: "If Michigan Swimming wants to align the meet with Zone format, and that is what is determined best, great, just not this late this year." So there was expressed support for this possible future change. The issue, with which I 100% concur, is that we published Board approved Time Standards, which are basically a contract with our Membership, which included these two events, thus communicating to our entire membership an expectation athletes achieving those times would be able to compete in those events.

I did communicate directly with each individual club, coach and parent that expressed concern/objection and offered A) my support of Program Operations and Technical Planning efforts to move the LSC forward, B) my assurance those events would be held this year, and C) my assurance should there be significant changes such as these next year or any year thereafter they would be first and foremost reflected clearly in the published Time Standards and secondly voted upon very early in the process and communicated well in advance of the effected season.

Again, thank you not only to Program Operations and Technical Planning but also to all of our interested members who communicated concerns directly and in a timely fashion so that everyone could be brought to the same page with minimal upheaval or discord, allowing for the opportunity to assure our customers that Michigan Swimming honors its contracts.

- 2. By way of Convention Update: I have submitted a formal request within required time frame to the USA Swimming President for At Large votes for Annual House of Delegates for Mary Perczak, John Loria and Jan Cartmill this year. I should receive an answer very soon. As Program Operations and Program Development each have a vote at Convention, I will be conferring the Program Development vote to Geneen Bradley, Diversity Chair. Both of our Athlete Reps are planning to attend again this year, Junior Rep Ellie Dean has secured clearance from her University Head Coach and Compliance Officer to participate in Convention. Our Junior Athlete Rep has also requested an At Large vote through Kelly Otto and has been assured she is first in line as she is first to request. Michigan Swimming is very fortunate to have these two devoted young women providing representation to our member athletes.
- 3. At this time I would ask that anyone who is normally sent to Convention that will NOT be planning to attend inform me as soon as possible. Those the By Laws dictate sending are: General Chair, Vice Chair of Administration, Program Operations, Program Development, Diversity Chair, Senior Coach Representative and the Junior and Senior Athlete Representative. John Loria and Jan Cartmill, for whom funds are annually budgeted, will be in attendance.
- 4. Finally, I would like to formally request the Board approve funding Mary Perczak to 2015 Convention. Dan Meconis, while asked first, has declined to attend or be funded by Michigan Swimming this year due to schedule conflicts. Mary has funded herself several previous conventions, most recent included, and plans to do so again as needed. With Finance Vice Chair position up for election this year, Mary provides consistency and a vast knowledge base as regards the financial well-being of the LSC. This will prove very important as we continue to look at our Strategic goal to move towards a brick and mortar operation. Mary will be charged specifically with gleaning as much from Convention as she can across all areas of finance as it affects the LSC. Mary Perczak is in the early months of a two year term and I contend an LSC of our size and future aspirations should be represented at Convention by a Board member serving our financial interests.

Requesting Motion and Vote to fund Mary Perczak, Treasurer, to convention.

5. REMINDER: Call to all Coaches, Club Presidents, Officials, Parents and everyone else interested who comes into contact with our athlete members to encourage participation in the Michigan Swimming Logo Contest. Let's get the word out and stay on top of getting our athletes interested and involved. The upcoming vote on our new logo should prove a very exciting and rewarding moment for all of us!
