D2 - The edition of East Grand Rapids made this year's D2 state meet one of the deepest fields we have seen in a long time. Our top Zone 8 finishers were Midland Dow 7th and Fenton 12th. Ella Roberson again led the Dow Chargers with a 2nd place finish in the 200 Free posting and All-American consideration time of 1:49.65 and a 1st place finish in the 100 Free with an All-American time of 50.13.
