
2010 NISCA Hall of Fame Award

In 1958, Kalos Kagathos Foundation was originally invited by NISCA to conceive, commission, and grant fund to Princeton Sculptor, Joe Brown the NISCA Hall of Fame Award. The Sculpture of the NISCA Hall of Fame Award is displayed at the International Swimming Hall of Fame in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida. A replica of the original sculpture is conferred during the annual NISCA Meeting and Conference.
