Camp Information

Thank you for considering the Bismarck and Bemidji Swim Camp for your swimmer this summer. This camp will emphasize stroke technique, starts, and turns. The camps deal with high density learning experiences. The swimmers will learn by moving. These swim camps are not training camps. Swimmers are asked to rest and recover between sessions.

Each camper will be using an advanced technology called SwimEars, which allows the coaches to communicate with the swimmers while they are swimming. Allowing coaches to give clues to the swimmer on how to make changes in their strokes to improve.

Last year's camps we had swimmers attending from 5 states. Camps filled up last year, so don't wait to register early.

All campers must be a minimum age of 11.

Dietrich Lawrence - a home grown talent, he swam as a Badger for the University of Wisconsin, competed in 1984 Olympic Trials, 1996 Team USA in the Monofin World Championships and continues to participate in USA Masters Swimming. Dietrich brings his dryland exercise experience of studying and practicing Pilates, Open and Closed Chain Mobility, Circular Strength Training, Flow Drills and Resilience Breathing. Plus he is a great communicator for all ages. Teacher first, swimmer second.

Jeff Steele - Coach Jeff is the Head Swim Coach at Bismarck Aquastorm which is a team of 300+ swimmers. Team has grown over 240% since 2012 under Coach Steele guidance with the team's first Olympic Trials qualifier in 2021, plus two more qualifiers at the 2024 Olympic Trials. He has coached several national qualifiers while leading the program in a great run of State Championships both Short and Long Course Titles. Coach Jeff will be at Bismarck camp only.
