SANCTION: Held under the sanction of USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming, Inc., #110109

LOCATION: Westchester Community College Pool

75 Grasslands Road Valhalla, NY 10595

FACILITY: 25 yard pool with six 7-foot lanes and non-turbulent lane lines. Shallow end of pool will be used for

continuous warm up and warm downs. Colorado electronic timing system and a single-line scoreboard.

Seating for 200 spectators.

The pool has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)

SESSIONS: 8am – Warm-up / 9am – Meet Start

FORMAT: This will be a timed finals event.

This is a deck seeded meet.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on January 8, 2011 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMER:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special

consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of

any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may be entered in 4 individual events and 1 relay per day. **No NT's will be accepted.**

Invited teams will be given priority in acceptance of entries.

Entries will be cut on a first come first serve basis for invited teams. The host team reserves the right to

keep its swimmers entered in the meet.

Emailed Hy-Tek entry file is preferred. If sending by mail, entries should be sent on disk. A Master Sheet

must accompany all entries.

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by: December 23, 2010

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you

do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$3.00 per individual even must accompany the entries.

Make check payable to: Condors Swim Club.

Payment must be received by **December 28, 2010** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: The first 40 minutes will be general warm-up. The last 20 minutes: lanes 2-7 will be open for one-way

sprints; lanes 1 & 8 will be designated for pace. Lanes 3 & 6 will be assigned as necessary. No diving will be allowed except in designated sprint lanes. All swimmers must be supervised by a coach. The

Meet Director reserves the right to assign lanes for warm-up based on the size of the meet.

SCRATCH: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events

scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid

USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do

not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Medals $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$, Ribbons $4^{th} - 6^{th}$. Each heat winner will receive a gold coin. Each team's coach will

have a treasure chest with their picture on it. Each heat winner will put their coin in their choice of treasure chest. The coach with the most coins in their chest at the end of the meet will walk the

plank (diving board).

warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee,

any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

From Cross-Westchester Expressway (Route 287).

Take Hartsdale Exit 4. Eastbound, turn left; westbound, turn right. North on Knollwood Road

(Route 100A) approx. 1/2 mile to Westchester Community College entrance on right.

From the Sprain Parkway.

Take Eastview Exit. Northbound, turn right; Southbound, turn left onto Route 100. Westchester


Community College entrance is approx. 1/4 mile on right.
