- LOCATION:** Monroe-Woodbury Middle School, 199 Dunderberg Road, Central Valley, NY 10917
- FACILITY:** 25 yard pool with 6 lanes. Colorado electronic timing system with 6 line scoreboard.
The pool **HAS** been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)
- SESSIONS:** Session 1: 8 & under and 9-10 – 8:00 AM Warm Up – 9:00 AM Start
Session 2: 11-12 and 13-18 – 12:00 PM Warm Up – 1:00 PM Start
- FORMAT:** Timed Finals
Pre-Seeded Meet
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.
All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.
Age on **October 23, 2011** will determine age for the entire meet.
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.
- ENTRIES:** Swimmers may swim a maximum of 3 individual events.
Entries are on a first come, first serve basis in the order they are received within the USA Swimming. 4 hour per session timeline. Hy-Tek entries are preferred.

- DEADLINE:** 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by **October 8, 2011**.
2: The final entry deadline for this meet is **October 15, 2011**
3: Metro entries received between **October 9, 2011** and **October 15, 2011** and all entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.
An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.
- ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of **\$3.00** per individual event and **\$8.00** per relay event must accompany the entries.
Make check payable to: **MW Swim Club**.
Payment must be received by **October 16, 2011** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.
- WARM-UP:** Warm Up lanes will be organized by teams. Lane assignments will be available the day of the meet.
- SCRATCHES:** Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

- COACHES:** In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
- AWARDS:** **Medals for 1-3 Place, Ribbons for 4-6 Place. Medals for 1-3 Relays.** Heat winner prizes will also be distributed.

- RULES:** The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.
The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.
- SAFETY:** Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.
"Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement"
It is understood that USA Swimming, Inc and Metropolitan Swimming, Inc shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event"
- WATER DEPTH:** USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."
"[Click and Input water Depth at 1 meter and at 5 meters]" -TBD

- ADMISSION:** **There will be an admission charge of \$3.00 per adult, per session. Programs will be available for \$2.00 each session.**

- PARKING:** **There is parking available on-site.**
- DIRECTIONS:** **NYS Thruway to Exit 16, Harriman. When you go through the toll, exit right towards Central Valley. At traffic light, go straight onto Ninnenger Road. About ¼ mile make right onto Dunderberg Road. The Middle School is the first school on your right. Enter main entrance and follow signs to the pool.**
