FACILITY: 25-yard pool with 6 lanes with bulkhead and non-turbulent lane lines. There is seating for 300

spectators. Colorado electronic timing system and the 6- line scoreboard will be used.

The pool has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)

FORMAT: This meet is a timed final event.

The meet will be deck seeded.

The 1650 may be limited to two heats of girls and two heats of boys. The 12 - Under 500 Free and the OPEN 400 IM will be swum fastest to slowest. All swimmers in the Friday Distance Session

must provide their own timers.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on October 28, 2011 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special **SWIMMERS:** consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of

any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: All athletes are limited to five (5) events per day.

Deck entries will be accepted, space permitting.

NT entries will NOT be accepted.

Hy-Tek entries will be accepted. An entry summary with a signed waiver must be received by

DEADLINE:

- 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by 10/14/2011.
- 2: The final entry deadline for this meet is 10/20/2011
- 3: Metro entries received between 10/14/2011 and 10/20/2011 and all entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$3.00 per individual event must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by October 28, 2011 for email entries. Payment must be included with all

mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: General warm-up with assigned lanes for the first 40 minutes. Sprint lanes and general lanes will

be available for the remaining 10 minutes. Lane assignments will be distributed along with the

scratch sheet for each session.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events

scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid

USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do

not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Distance Session:

OPEN 400 IM: 1 - 6 place awards will be given for each of

the following age groups: 10 and under, 11 - 12, 13 - 14 and 15 - 18.

12 and under events (500 and 200 IM): 1 - 6 place awards will be given for

each of the following age groups: 10 and under and 11 - 12.

OPEN 1650: 1 – 6 place awards will be given.

Regular Sessions:

Awards will be given in all events for 1st through 6th places.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout

warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee,

any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

"Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's

legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement"
