FACILITY: The pool at Ward Melville HS is 25 yards and has 6 lanes with non-turbulent lane lines.

SESSIONS: Sunday -7am warm-up, 8am start

Any changes in warmup times will be posted 1 week before the start of the meet.

FORMAT: This meet is a timed finals format.

Deck seeding will be used.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on January 6, 2013 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY

ENTRIES: SWIMMERS MAY BE ENTERED IN A MAXIMUM OF 5 INDIVIDUAL EVENTS PER SESSION.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE IN YARDS!! NT's WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

DEADLINE: 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by December 16,2012.

2: The final entry deadline for this meet is December 23, 2012 or until meet fills to capacity

3: Metro entries received between October 17, 2012 and October 23, 2012 and all entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you

do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$4.00 per individual event, 10.00 per relay must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by January 6, 2013 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: Warm ups will be based on team/size, You will receive a warm up schedule upon check in.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events

scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid

USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do

not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Individual awards will be medals 1st thru 6rd and ribbons 7th thru 12th.

Relay awards will be medals 1st place.

Awards can only be picked up by a coach during the meet. Any awards not picked

up will be mailed to the coach. .

> The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is

prohibited.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout

warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee,

any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

"Any swimmer entered in the

meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal quardian, to ensure

compliance with this requirement"

WATER DEPTH: USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for

a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."
