Session 5: Sunday Morning – Warm-Up 8:00 AM, Start 9:00 AM
Session 6: Sunday Afternoon – Warm-Up 1:00 PM, Start 2:00 PM

**FORMAT:** Events are Timed Finals and will be deck seeded.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on 11/16/2012, will determine age for the entire meet.

**SEEDING:** This meet will be Deck Seeded. Seeding will be done at the beginning of each session using a scratch

sheet procedure.

All Friday night events will be seeded fastest to slowest

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special

consideration.

The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability

prior to the competition.

**ENTRIES:** All athletes are limited to enter 5 events per session.

The 1650 may be limited to 4 heats (2 male, 2 female)

Entries will be entered on a first come/ first serve basis. Entries must be sent via Hy-tek file either by disk or e-mail. However, payment must be received by entry deadline for entries to be recognized.

**DEADLINE:** 

1: Metro LSC teams and HAWK-AD will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams and HAWK-AD entries must be received by November 1, 2012

#### 2: The final entry deadline for this meet is November 9, 2012

3: Metro entries received between November 2, 2012 and November 9, 2012, and all entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 1 day of your original email.

**ENTRY FEE:** 

An entry fee of \$4 per individual even must accompany the entries.

Make check payable to: Minisink Valley Aquatics (MVA).

Payment must be received by November 15, 2012, for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP:

The first 30-40 minutes will be general warm-up. The last 15-20 minutes: lanes 2-7 will be open for one-way sprints; lanes 1 & 8 will be designated for pace. No diving will be allowed except in designated sprint lanes. All swimmers must be supervised by a coach.

SCRATCHES:

Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES:

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded places 1-6 for individual events.

Ribbons will be awarded 1-3 for relay events.

High Point Trophy for male and female high point scorer in each age group. Heat Winner awards will be given to the winner of each heat of each event.
