## **YWCA Middies Distance Meet**

**SANCTION:** Held under the sanction of USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming, Inc., # 130201

LOCATION: **YWCA of White Plains**

**FACILITY:** One 6x7' lane 25 yard course. Non-turbulent lane lines. Colorado electronic timing system with 6

line scoreboard.

The pool has been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)

**SESSIONS:** Session 1: Sunday, February 17, 8 am warm up, 9 am start

Session 2: Saturday, February 17, 1 pm warm up, 2 pm start

FORMAT: All events will be timed finals, deck seeding. All events will be held fastest to slowest.

**NOTE RE: Afternoon session – 1650 free:** 

The session will run fastest to slowest and alternate women and men. Depending on the number of entries in the 1650, this session may be split into 2 sessions with an additional 15-20 minute warm

up period between sessions.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on February 17, 2013 will determine age for the entire meet.

**DISABILITY** 

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special

SWIMMERS: consideration.

The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to

the competition.

**ENTRIES:** Swimmers are limited to 3 events + 1 relay in session 1, 3 events + 1 relay in session 2.

This meet will be run using Hy-Tek's Meet Manager. All files must be emailed in Hy-Tek format.

An email confirming receipt of entries along with a meet manager report will be returned to the

coach.

DEADLINE: 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by Tuesday, February 5, 2013.

2: The final entry deadline for this meet is Tuesday, February 12, 2013.

3: Metro entries received between February 5, and February 12, 2013 and all entries from other LSC's will

be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do

not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

**ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of \$4.00 per individual even must accompany the entries.

Make check payable to: YWCA Middies.

Payment must be received by February 12, 2013 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail

entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: Warm up sessions will be assigned and each team will have 20 minutes to complete. All lanes will

open for the last 10 minutes for specific warm up.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

**COACHES:** In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA

Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not

possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Heat Winner duckies will be handed out per heat.

Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> place per age group.

**DIRECTOR:** 

**RULES:** The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-

ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any

swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

"Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being

proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When

unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal

guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement"

WATER USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for a

**DEPTH:** distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."

The water depth is 3 feet at the shallow end and 10 feet deep at the diving end.

AUDIO/VISUAL Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing

STATEMENT: areas, rest rooms or locker rooms

Bryant Ave. Turn right and continue to North St. Turn left and drive one block. YWCA is on right.

Heading West (from Port Chester or Connecticut):

Tke Exit 9S. After light bear right onto the Hutchinson River Pkwy South. Take Exit 25W as

above.

From I-684:

Follow to end which merges with the Hutchinson River Pkwy. Take Exit 25W as above.
