Session 2: Saturday Morning – Warm-Up 7:00 AM, Start 8:15 AM Session 3: Saturday Afternoon – Warm-Up 12:30 PM, Start 1:45 PM Session 4: Sunday Morning – Warm-Up 7:00 AM, Start 8:15 AM Session 5: Sunday Afternoon – Warm-Up 12:30 PM, Start 1:45 PM

FORMAT: This will be a timed finals event.

This will be a deck-seeded event.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on **July 10, 2015** will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMER:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any

disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES:

Swimmers may be entered in 3 individual events per day. Swimmers may be entered in 1 individual event on Friday. **No NT's will be accepted.** Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. The meet will be closed once the timeline can no longer support additional entries.

Emailed Hy-Tek entry file is preferred. If sending by mail, entries should be sent on disk. A Master Sheet must accompany all entries.

DEADLINE: Entries must be received by: June 26, 2015

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you

do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$5.00 per individual event must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by June 26, 2015 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: The host team reserves the right to assign lanes for warm-up based on the size of the meet. If lane

assignments become necessary, there will be 3, 20-minute sessions on Friday evening and 3 25-minute sessions on Saturday and Sunday. No diving will be allowed except in designated sprint lanes, which will

be announced. A coach must supervise all swimmers.

SCRATCH: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events

scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA

Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not

possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded for places 1st – 8th

Awards will be scored for 10 & Unders and 11-12's for the 12 & Under events. Awards will be scored 10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14, and 15 & Over for the open events

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area.

Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

WATER DEPTH: USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for a

distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."

1.0 meter = 4 feet 6 inches, 5 meters = 13 feet

PARKING:

There is ample on-site parking next to the pool. Please park in the school lots to avoid ticketing or towing.

From North of Rockland County: Take Palisades Interstate Parkway South to Exit 10. Make a left off the exit. Make a left at the first traffic light onto Middletown Road. Take a right at next traffic light onto Germonds Road...

From the George Washington Bridge: Take Palisades Interstate Parkway North to Exit 10. Make a right off the exit onto Germonds Road...

DIRECTIONS:

From the Tappan Zee Bridge: Take the NYS Thruway (I-87 North) to Exit 13N (Palisades Interstate Parkway – North). Take Palisades Interstate Parkway North to Exit 10. Make a right off the exit onto Germonds Road...

...follow Germonds Road through the intersection of Germonds Road and Route 304 (you will pass Albertus Magnus High School on your right). Make a left onto Parrott Road. The entrance for the pool is down the walkway at the end of the tennis courts.
