FACILITY: Newburgh Free Academy Natatorium is a 25-Yard pool with 6 lanes, non-turbulent lane dividers, and

Colorado Timing System with IST display scoreboard. There is seating for 350 spectators.

The pool has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)

SESSIONS: Session 1 & 3: Warm-up 7:30am, Meet Starts 8:30am

Session 2 & 4: Warm-up 12:30pm, Meet Starts 2:00pm

FORMAT: All events are timed finals.

Seeding will be conducted at the beginning of each session utilizing a scratch sheet procedure.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on December 6, 2014 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special

- 3: Metro entries received between November 17<sup>th</sup> and November 29<sup>th</sup> and all entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows

WARM-UP:

General warm-up procedures will be in effect.

**SCRATCHES:** Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events

scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

**COACHES:** 

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not

possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: High point trophies will be awarded for 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, and 13-14 age groups. Custom bag

tags will be awarded for 1st through 6th place in 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, and 13-14 events. There will be no awards for open events. Bag tags will be awarded for the top 3 relays. First, second, and third place

team awards will also be awarded.
