Colorado Timing System with IST display scoreboard. There is seating for 350 spectators.

The pool has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)

SESSIONS: Session 1 & 3: Warm-up 7:30am, Meet Starts 8:30am

Session 2 & 4: Warm-up 12:30pm, Meet Starts 2:00pm

FORMAT: All events are timed finals.

Seeding will be conducted at the beginning of each session utilizing a scratch sheet procedure.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on December 5 2015 will determine the age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special

SWIMMERS: consideration.

The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior

to the competition.

ENTRIES: Swimmers may enter a maximum of 5 individual events for per day.

Entries will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. All entries must be submitted with Hy-

DEADLINE:

- 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by Monday. November 16th 2015.
- 2: The final entry deadline for this meet is Monday November 23rd 2015
- 3: Metro entries received between November 16^h and November 23rdand all entries from other LSC's

will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you

do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$4.00 per individual event and \$8.00 per relay must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by Monday November 23rd for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the

meet.

WARM-UP: General warm-up procedures will be in effect.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events

scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA

Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not

possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: High point trophies will be awarded for 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, and 13-14 age groups. Custom bag

tags will be awarded for 1st through 6th place in 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12, and 13-14 events. There will be no awards for open events. Bag tags will be awarded for the top 3 relays. First, second, and third place

team awards will also be awarded.
