All events will be swum as timed finals. Deck seeded with Scratch Sheets collected 40 minutes prior FORMAT:

to the start of each session. Heat sheets will be distributed and posted.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

Age on FRIDAY, DECEMBER 11<sup>TH</sup> will determine age for the entire meet.

**ENTRIES:** All athletes are limited to enter 3 events Friday and 4 events per day on Saturday and Sunday. NO TIME

DEADLINE: 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be received by November 27th.

2: The final entry deadline for this meet is December 4th.

3: Metro entries received between November 27th and December 4th and all entries from other LSC's will be

entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do

not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

An entry fee of \$4.00 per individual event, \$5.00 swimmer surcharge **ENTRY FEE:**

Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in

teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP: General warm-up will begin 90 minutes prior to start of each session and 25yd, sprint lanes

designated 30 minutes prior to start of each session.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30

minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches

and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA

Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not

possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Individual events 1-3 place/Medals, 4-6 place/Ribbons. Relay events 1-3 place/Ribbons. NO awards will be

given for Open events.
