FORMAT: This meet will be run as a Timed Finals meet, seeded slowest to fastest.

This meet will be deck-seeded. All scratch sheets are due at the administrative table 35 mins before

session start time.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

No "Deck Registrations" will be accepted

Age on October 13, 2018 will determine age for the entire meet.

WARM-UP: Assigned Warmups will be posted on deck

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later

than 35 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual

events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid

USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who

do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Awards for 12 and unders, places 1-6. No awards for Session 2 and 3.

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

> The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area.

> Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. "Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure

compliance with this requirement"

WATER DEPTH: USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured

for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."

Water Depth at 1 meter - 11 feet, Water Depth at 5 Meters - 7 feet
