FORMAT: The meet is a Timed Trial Final Event. The meet will be Pre-Seeded.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited Teams and Freedom Aquatics USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers. All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. Age on November 21st 2020 will determine age for the entire meet.

ENTRIES: All Athletes are limited to enter 5 individual events per session. Deck entries will not be accepted.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: **AWARDS:** Trophies for Top 3 Places in overall IMR Standings, Must Compete in all of the IMR Events to be Eligible for Trophy. Age Group Categories: 7 Year Olds, 8 Year Olds, 9, Years Olds and 10 Years Olds. No awards for individual events will be provided.

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

AUDIO/VISUAL STATEMENT:**Drones:**

Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, behind the blocks or locker rooms "Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present."

POLICY: Any photographer or videographer, who intends to take pictures at a Metropolitan Swimming meet, must complete and submit a Photographer Registration Form to the Meet Manager before commencing activity.

RULES: Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee



All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Make sure all interactions with athletes are observable and interruptible.
Current USA Swimming and Metropolitan Swimming certification is required for all officials and the Meet Referee may check your cards.

SAFETY: NEW Special Safety Protocol will be in place! Please review and sign the attachment below under the “events page”. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the NEW Special Safety Protocols.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

DECK CHANGING: Is Prohibited

TECH SUIT/SWIMWEAR POLICY: Swimwear must conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.8. Only swimsuits complying with FINA swimsuit specification may be worn in any USA Swimming sanctioned or Approved competition. "Tech suits" are not permitted at this meet for 12 & under swimmers. "Tech Suits" are defined as a suit that has Bonded Seams, Kinetic Tape, or Meshed Seams. 2020 MR FREE IM READY MEET SAFETY PROTOCOL

All swimmers and parents **MUST** adhere to the following guidelines and protocols in place in order to provide the safest environment to conduct this meet.

After reading these guidelines, and reviewing them with your swimmer, please sign the attached waiver form to confirm that you are fully aware of these new safety protocols as well as disciplinary actions associated with them.

Health Screenings

Temperature screening will be required upon entry of Brooklyn Sports Club Facility. Adults on the pool deck must affirm that they have not travelled to any state that is on the NYS quarantine List in the last 14 days. Anyone found that may have traveled will be asked to leave immediately. Coaches will affirm that their entered swimmers have not travelled to any state that is on the NYS quarantine list in the past 14 days.

Safety Guidelines

Check-in Procedures for Athletes, volunteers, and coaches will take place in front of the entrance of Brooklyn Sports Club Facility. Face coverings are required. All Participants must adhere to social distancing rules while awaiting to get their temperature screen. Volunteers will be issued a wrist-band to wear and allowed in the facility. Athletes will proceed to enter the building and go to the appropriate locker room to change.

Spectators, Parents and Guardians

There will be no spectators, parents and guardians allowed in The Brooklyn Sport Club Facility. This meet will be live streamed on Freedom Aquatics social media sites. Meet results will be made available on meet mobile.

Swimmers

All swimmers entering the facility will be required to wear a face covering.

Swimmers will enter the facility in an orderly manner, practicing social distancing and will follow the instructions of the Safety Marshall's, Coaches and/or Meet Volunteers.

Meet Protocols

Swimmers will be staged in the 25 Yard Competition pool deck area under the supervision of a Safety Marshall.



Only the current heat will be on the competition pool deck prior to each heat. All timers should practice social distancing and maintain 6 feet apart from each other and all swimmers.

Swimmers will place their towel and other belongings in the plastic bins which will be placed next to their chairs behind starting blocks. A designated parent volunteer will bring these bins to the wading pool area.

Upon completion of each heat, swimmers will cool down by swimming to the other side of the pool and will proceed to the wading pool area to retrieve their belongings (if any) and will then proceed to the 25 yard pool deck and/or areas designated by their coach to wait for their next event.

All Swimmers, Coaches, Attendees and Volunteers

Face coverings must be worn **AT ALL TIMES** while inside the Brooklyn Sports Club Facility. Anyone found to not be wearing a face covering will be asked to leave the facility immediately.

Please adhere to all protocols above so that we may continue to provide meets for our swimmers. Any violation of the protocols outlined above may lead to the Brooklyn Sports Club facility voiding our rental agreement.
