3 hour sessions maximum time line- ALL SESSIONS

FORMAT: This is a Timed Finals Meet. Events will be swum Slowest to Fastest.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.

No "Deck Registrations" will be accepted

Age on November 12, 2022 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS: Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need

special consideration.

The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any

disability prior to the competition.

**ENTRIES:** All Athletes are limited to enter 4 events per session

Deck entries will not be accepted.

NT's will not be accepted.

Entries are by invited teams only. Hy-Tek Email entries will be accepted

**DEADLINE:** 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro team's entries

must be received by November 1, 2022

2: The final entry deadline for this meet is November 5, 2022

3: Metro entries received between October 25, 2022 and November 1, 2022 will be entered first.

Entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet

Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

**ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of \$8.00 per individual event must accompany the entries.

A \$10.00 Facility Surcharge per swimmer will apply and must accompany the entries.

Make check payable to: Sachem Swim Club of Long Island, Inc.

Payment must be received by 11/12/2022 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers.

Coaches should contact meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered

for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

**WARM-UP:** General warm up with assigned lanes. Lane assignments will be distributed along with the meet

program each session.

**SCRATCHES:** Scratches are due 30 minutes before session start.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA

Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not

possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: All ages will receive awards, 1st thru # of lanes the pool is run in.

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

MAAPP POLICY: All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions

of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that

compliance with MAAPP is condition of participation in the conduct of this competitions.

SAFETY: All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area.

Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. "Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure

compliance with this requirement"

**WATER DEPTH:** USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for

a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."

1 Meter – 15 Feet, 5 Meter – 12 Feet

No glass will be permitted on the deck.

A Swim Vendor may be available throughout the entire meet.

**PARKING:** Free Parking available in Lots 1 and 1A of Eisenhower Park

CAPACITY: Current NYS/Nassau County Regulations apply

DIRECTIONS: FROM VERRAZANO NARROWS BRIDGE AND KENNEDY AIRPORT:

Follow signs to Belt Parkway/Long Island East. Take Belt Parkway eastbound past Kennedy Airport – after Kennedy Airport stay in the left lane and look for signs to Southern State Parkway East. Take Southern State Pkwy East to Meadowbrook Pkwy (northbound) to NY-24 Hempstead Turnpike (exit M4) East.

On Hempstead Turnpike go to the left lane and make a left at the first light (Merrick Ave.) At first traffic light make a right. This is the entrance to the pool.

#### FROM WHITESTONE AND THROGS NECK BRIDGES

Take Cross Island Parkway South to Exit 29, Grand Central Parkway eastbound. Follow Grand Central Pkwy to Meadowbrook Pkwy southbound (Jones Beach). Get off Meadowbrook Pkwy at NY-24 Hempstead Tpke.(exit M4).

On Hempstead Turnpike go to the left lane and make a left at the first light (Merrick Ave.)

At first traffic light make a right. This is the entrance to the pool.
