- FACILITY:** **6-lane, 25 yard pool. Colorado touchpads and scoreboard.**
The competition course **has not** been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming.
- SESSIONS:** **Session 1**
5:00pm Warmup
5:45pm Start
- Session 2**
Starts immediately following Session 1, No Warmup or Break Between Sessions
- FORMAT:** **All events are Timed Finals except the 9-12 50 yard freestyle**
All events will be Deck Seeded
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers. Additional teams may request invitation by emailing the meet director. All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. No Deck Registrations will be accepted. Age on **July 12, 2023** will determine age for the entire meet.
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.
- ENTRIES:** **Maximum 4 Individual Events, 3 if including prelims/finals.**

- DEADLINE:** **Entries must be received by: 12:00am, July 5, 2023**
An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact the Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.
- ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of **\$10** per individual event and **\$10** per athlete surcharge must accompany the entries. Make check payable to: **Hauppauge Athletic Association**
Payment must be received by **July 12, 2023** for email entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.
- Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the Meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.
- WARM-UP:** **Warmup lanes will be assigned based on entries accepted and posted at the pool.**
- SCRATCHES:** Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session. No scratches from Finals are allowed.
- COACHES:** In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid

USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

- AWARDS:** **Medals for 1-3rd place, Ribbons for 4-6th place**

- RULES:** The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.
The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.
- SAFETY:** Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Lifeguards and an AED will be present.**
- MAAPP POLICY:** All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- WATER DEPTH:** **The pool is 12 feet deep at 1m from the start end, and 11 feet and 6 inches at 5m from the start end. The pool is 3 feet 6 inches deep at 1m from the turn end, and 4 feet at 5m from the turn end.**
- DISCLAIMER:** **DISCLAIMER:** Upon acceptance of his/her entries, the participant waives all claims against Hauppauge High School, Hauppauge Athletic Association, Metropolitan Swimming Inc., USA Swimming Inc., their agents or representatives for any injury occurring as a result of the meet. It is understood that USA Swimming, Inc. and Metropolitan Swimming, Inc. shall be free from liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
- AUDIO/VISUAL STATEMENT:** Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- DECK CHANGING:** Deck changes are prohibited.
- ADMISSION:** **Admissions to all sessions are free.**
- MERCHANTS:** **Limited concessions may be available.**
- PARKING:** **Ample free parking is available north of the High School.**
