SANCTION: Held under the sanction of USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming, Inc., # 231109, 231156-TT

LOCATION: Yonkers Montessori School, 160 Woodlawn Avenue Yonkers, New York 10704

FACILITY: 25 Yard pool with 8 6ft lanes and non-turbulent lane lines. Colorado electronic timing system. The pool is not certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4). 10 feet in deep end, 4 feet in shallow end.

NO SMOKING ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING. Teams are expected to police and maintain their areas on the pool deck. Athletes, parents and children are restricted to the pool area and spectators stands and are not authorized to be in any other part of the building.

SESSIONS: Only one Session: warm-up Sunday 11:30 am Meet Starts 12:30 pm.

FORMAT: The meet is a Timed Final Event. The meet will be Deck Seeded

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. No Deck Registrations will be accepted. Age on November 26, 2023, will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS: Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the Meet Director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to

the competition.

ENTRIES: All Athletes are limited to enter 4 events for this session.

Deck entries will not be accepted.

NT's will not be accepted

Entries are by invite only on a first come first serve basis.

Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet. Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the Meet Director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP: General warm up with assigned lanes for the first 40 minutes. Sprint lanes and General lanes will be available for the remaining 10 minutes. Lane assignments will be distributed along with the scratch sheet each session.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for this session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: 1st - 8th place awards will be given to the 12&U (11-12 & 10&under) athletes in individual events.

Questions: Concerning the meet will only be entertained when communicated via a certified coach on an invited team.

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.
The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.
Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach. as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the

water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement. Mark Twain pool Lifeguards and an AED are on site.

MAAPP POLICY: All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

WATER DEPTH: 12 feet in deep end, 4 feet in shallow end.
