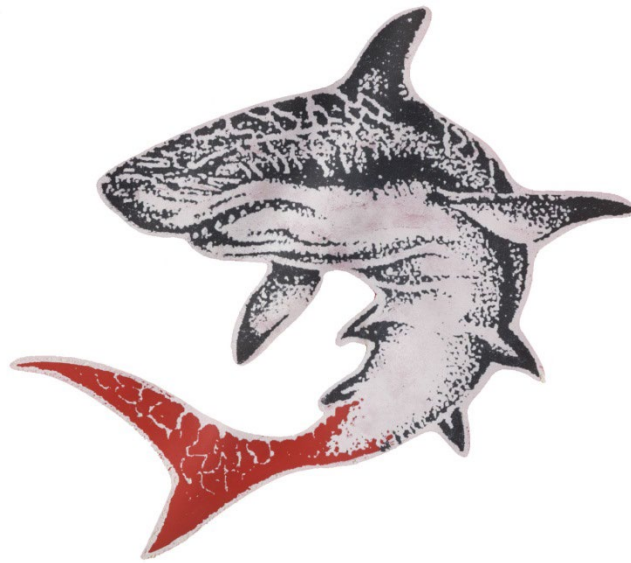

- SANCTION:** Held under the sanction of USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming, Inc., #240605
- LOCATION:** **Lehman College APEX Center;**
250 Bedford Park Blvd. West Bronx, NY 10468
- FACILITY:** Eight lanes 50 Meters Olympic size indoor pool, **pool depth is 4ft to 13ft.** Electronic timing system and non-turbulent lane lines will be used.
The pool **has been** certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4). A copy of such Certificate is on file with USA Swimming.
- SESSIONS:** **Saturday, June 22, 2024- Session I: 8:00am warm up- 9:15am Start**
Saturday, June 22, 2024- Session II: 2:00pm warm up- 3:15pm Start
Sunday, June 23, 2024- Session III: 8:00am warm up- 9:15am Start
Sunday, June 23, 2024- Session IV: 2:00pm warm up- 3:15pm Start
- FORMAT:** **All events are Timed Finals**
The meet will Deck Seeded
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.
No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. International swimmers invited by USA Swimming may attend.
No "Deck Registrations" will be accepted. Age on **June 17th** will determine age for the entire meet.
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.
- ENTRIES:** Swimmers are allowed only 3 individual events and 1 relay per day.
Entries will be cut by team in order to maintain Metro swimming guidelines.
HY-TEK entries w/ printout are preferred.

- DEADLINE:** **Entries must be received by: June 1, 2024. Metro Teams may enter prior to May 21, 2024**
An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.
- ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of **\$7.00** per individual event, **\$10.00** per Relay event, and a **\$10.00** per swimmer Surcharge fee must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by **the entry deadline** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.
- WARM-UP:** **Lane assignments will be posted, if necessary, prior to each warm up session**
- SCRATCHES:** Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

- COACHES:** In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
- AWARDS:** A distinctive medal will be given to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places. Ribbons for places 4 through 8. High Point awards will be given to top three individuals in each age division and top three teams.

- RULES:** The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.
The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.
The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.
- SAFETY:** Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.
"Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement"
- WATER DEPTH:** USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."
Pool depth is 4ft to 13ft.

Deck Changing is prohibited.

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

ADMISSION:

Spectators are permitted. Tickets must be purchased in advance online for admission to each session Through Ticketleap. Teams will receive the ticket info link prior to the meet. Meet Mobile may also be available.

MERCHANTS:

Refreshments and food will not be available

PARKING:

Street parking will be available.

PHOTOGRAPHY

Any photographer or videographer, who intends to take pictures at a Metropolitan Swimming Sanctioned meet, must complete and submit a Photographer Registration Form to the Meet Director before commencing Activity. Policy: Any photographer or videographer, who intends to take pictures at a Metropolitan Swimming sanctioned meet, must complete and submit a Photographer Registration Form to the Meet Director before commencing activity. Forms are available on the Metropolitan Swimming website as well as from the Meet Director.

Swimmer's families, taking photos of their children from the spectator area, are not subject to this policy.

Notes:

The above policy will be published in meet announcements and programs.

It is the Meet Director's responsibility to have forms available at the meet.

The Meet Director should check the actual ID against entry on form, and keep a file of submitted forms.

The intent is to promote accountability and to give Meet Directors and Referees a tool for managing concerns about photographers. Teams should consider providing a lanyard indicating that the photographer is registered.

Professional photographers/videographers will be allowed on deck at the discretion of the Meet Director and Meet Referee, and must adhere to the following guidelines:

Do not stand on the starting end of the pool, or in the starter's box; use of the bulkhead is at the discretion of the Meet Director and Meet Referee.

Do not stand on the edge of the pool (leave approximately two feet for officials and coaches).

Leave the deck when not actively photographing.

Respond immediately to direction from the Meet Referee.
