ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers from designated Silvers South teams. All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302. No Deck Registrations will be accepted

Age on February 21, 2025 will determine age for the entire meet.

Qualifying times must be achieved between **January 1**, **2024** and the entry deadline.

As voted on at the BOD of February 28, 2013: If a swimmer ages-up to a new age group between the first day of Silvers (February 23, 2024) and the first day of Junior Mets (March 14, 2025), and that swimmer has a Junior Mets qualifying time in the age group they are during Silvers (making that





swimmer ineligible to swim at Silvers), but that swimmer does not have a Junior Mets qualifying time in that same event in the new age group by the meet extension deadline of Junior Mets, that swimmer would be able to swim that event as exhibition/non award at Silvers. Example: Jane Doe is 10-year-old as of February 21 on the first day of Silvers; her time in the 50 free is 31.00 (which is a Junior Mets time in the 50 free) so she can't swim that event at Silvers. Now her 31.00 in the 50 free is too slow for Junior Mets in the 11-12 age group. So now under this policy, Jane would be allowed to swim the 50 free at Silvers in the 11-12 age group as Exhibition only. Entries for that swimmer should be clicked as X (exhibition) in Team Manager/Team Unify. In addition, the name of the swimmers involved in this new policy should be clearly added in the text of the Silvers Entries.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

NTs (No Times) are not permitted. Converted times are not permitted. **Maximum 5 events per athlete per day. An Entry Report, with proof of times, must accompany the entries.**

All entries must be in yards. A SWIMS Times Recon will be done prior to the meet. Times must have been achieved within the qualifying time period and must be in the SWIMS database. Entry times not found in the SWIMS will be scratched. Bonus events must be indicated in the entry file.

Metro Policies and Procedures 310.10.1

"Make 1 get 1 bonus swim for any 50/100 yard event; no NT's allowed. If after adding 1 bonus swim for athletes with 1 cut time the meet timeline is under 4.0 hours (using a minimum of +15 seconds & +15 seconds for backstroke) the host team may add swimmers that have not met the qualifying standard to events of 50 & 100 yards in length, no NT's allowed, to get the timeline to 4.0 hours."

DEADLINE:

Entries must be received by: 10:00 pm on February 13, 2025

ENTRY FEE:



All fees should be submitted by a coach or team administrator, not by individual parents.

An entry fee of \$7.50 per timed final event, a facility surcharge of \$10 per athlete, and a Metro Surcharge of \$1 per athlete must accompany the entries.

USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches

who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
