FACILITY: Valley Central HS Natatorium is an 8 lane, 25 yard competition pool with Colorado Timing

System and Scoreboard.

The competition course has NOT been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4).

Session 2: Sat PM 1:00 PM Warmups – 2:00 PM Start Session 3: Sun AM 7:30 AM Warmups – 9:00 AM Start Session 4: Sun PM 1:00 PM Warmups – 2:00 PM Start

FORMAT: All events are swum as timed finals. NTs will not be accepted.

Deck seeded.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer

will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

No Deck Registrations will be accepted

Age on **December 6**, 2025 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the Meet Director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible

for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Athletes are permitted 5 individual events plus 1 relay per day. NT entries are not permitted.

Entries will be accepted in order they are received.

An email confirming receipt of entries will be sent. Please contact the Meet Director if you do not

receive confirmation of receipt within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$10 per individual event, \$20 per relay, and a \$7.50 athlete surcharge must

accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by November 30, 2025. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could

result in teams being barred from the meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers.

Coaches should contact the Meet Director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish

considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP: Assigned warmups will be in effect. The host team will post warmup assignments before the

meet. All swimmers must be supervised by a coach during warm-ups.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later

than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual

event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet.

Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Awards for Individual events for 8 & Under, 9-10, 11-12 will be given for places 1-8.

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

Swimmers who come without a coach must contact the Meet Director and will be assigned a

coach on deck.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet.

Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the

safety rules.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the

swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Lifeguards will be on deck during warmups and sessions. AED is located on the pool deck.

MAAPP POLICY: All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the

provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this

competition.

WATER DEPTH: Start End: depth at 1 meter is 10'8"; depth at 5 meters is 9'9"

Turn End: depth at 1 meter is 3'4"; depth at 5 meters in 4'0"

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach

areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or

spectators are present.

DECK CHANGING:

Deck changes are prohibited.

will be available for \$3.
