SANCTION: Held under the sanction of USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming, Inc., # 251009

LOCATION: Bard College Pool, Stevenson Gym, Bard College, Annandale-on-Hudson, NY 12504

FACILITY: 25 yard pool with six 7-foot lanes; non-turbulent lane lines; seating for 150 available;

Colorado electronic timing system and scoreboard.

The competition course has NOT been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4).

SESSIONS: 1 Session. Warm-ups at 7:30 am – Meet starts at 8:30 am

FORMAT: All events are timed finals. Slow to fast seeding. Deck seeded.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer

will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

No deck registrations will be accepted.

Age on October 12, 2025 will determine age for the entire meet.

**DISABILITY** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director

**SWIMMERS:** of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible

for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Swimmers are permitted 5 individual events per session.

**DEADLINE:** 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must

be received by September 30, 2025.

2: The final entry deadline for this meet is October 1, 2025.

3: Metro Entries received between September 12, 2025 and October 1, 2025.

Entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows. An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact the Meet

Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

**ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of \$5 per individual event and \$7.50 per swimmer surcharge must accompany the

entries.

Make check payable to: NDAC.

Payment must be received by **October 4**, **2025** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from

the meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers.

Coaches should contact the Meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish

considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP: General warm-up procedures will be in effect

**SCRATCHES:** Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no

later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly

individual event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Events will be scored as following:

6&Under, 8&Under, 10&Under, 11-12 Individual Events: Ribbons for places 1-6

13-14, 15-18 Pentathlon, must swim all 5 events: High Point Awards will be given to the top 3

individuals in 13-14 and 15-18 age categories.

**RULES:** The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

**SAFETY:** Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet.

Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to

follow the safety rules.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Life guards and AED on site.

**MAAPP POLICY:** All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the

provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this

competition.

WATER DEPTH: Start end: Water depth at 1 meter from the wall is 13 feet, at 5 meters it is 12 feet.

Turn end: Water depth at 1 meter from the wall is 4 feet, at 5 meters it is 4.5 feet.

AUDIO/VISUAL STATEMENT:

Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas,

rest rooms, locker rooms.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools,

athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches,

officials and/or spectators are present.

**DECK CHANGING:** Deck changes are prohibited.

ADMISSION: All spectators are encouraged to use the Meet Mobile App in conjunction with the free wifi provided

by the facility. Electronic Heat Sheets will be made available for free on the Meet Mobile App.

Printed Heat Sheets will be available for \$2.

**MERCHANTS:** Swimsuits, goggles and apparel will be available on site. Food will be available for purchase.

PARKING: Parking lot on Annandale Rod across the Stevenson Gym. Illegally parked cars will be

towed at the owner's expense.
