The meet will be deck-seeded. Events will be seeded Slow to Fast.

Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers. **ELIGIBILITY:**

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer

will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

No Deck Registrations will be accepted

Age on November 15, 2025 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible SWIMMERS:

for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: All Athletes are limited to enter 4 events per session. Deck entries will not be accepted.

Relays subject to cancellation for over subscription. NT's will not be accepted.

NTs will be REJECTED.

Host Team reserves the right to enter NT for their swimmers.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet.

Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

No glass will be permitted on the deck.

A Swim Vendor may be available throughout the entire meet.

PARKING: Free Parking is available in Lots 1 and 1A of Eisenhower Park.

DIRECTIONS: FROM VERRAZANO NARROWS BRIDGE AND KENNEDY AIRPORT:

- Follow signs to Belt Parkway/Long Island East.
- Take Belt Parkway eastbound past Kennedy Airport after Kennedy Airport stay in the left lane and look for signs to Southern State Parkway East.
- Take Southern State Pkwy East to Meadowbrook Pkwy (northbound) to NY-24 Hempstead Turnpike (exit M4) East.
- On Hempstead Turnpike go to the left lane and make a left at the first light (Merrick Ave.)
- At first traffic light make a right. This is the entrance to the pool.

FROM WHITESTONE AND THROGS NECK BRIDGES:

- Take Cross Island Parkway South to Exit 29, Grand Central Parkway eastbound.
- Follow Grand Central Pkwy to Meadowbrook Pkwy southbound (Jones Beach).
- Get off Meadowbrook Pkwy at NY24 Hempstead Tpke. (exit M4).
- On Hempstead Turnpike go to the left lane and make a left at the first light (Merrick Ave.)
- At first traffic light make a right. This is the entrance to the pool.
