ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited 13-Over USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers. All

swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer

will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

No Deck Registrations will be accepted.

Age on July 17, 2024, will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet **SWIMMERS:** director of any accommodation you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also

responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Swimmers are limited to 2 events per session.

> Invited teams will be given priority in the acceptance of entries. The host team reserves the right to limit the session to 150 swimmers and/or split it into two sessions. Entries will be accepted on

a first come, first served basis for invited teams. Deck entries will not be accepted.

The meet will be run on computer using Hy-Tek's Meet Manager.

Teams must submit entries using an export file of Hy-Tek Team Manager. Payment must be received by Saturday, July 17, 2024. Paper entries, phoned, or faxed entries will NOT be accepted. An email confirming receipt of entries and a meet manager meet entries report will be sent to the coach. Please email Monique if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original

ENTRY FEE: SURCHARGE: An entry fee of \$10.00 per individual event and \$15.00 surcharge per swimmer must accompany

DEADLINE: 1: Entries will be accepted on a first come/first served basis until the cap of 150 swimmers is

reached.

3: An email will be sent confirming receipt of entries. Please contact the meet Director if you do

not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

WARM-UP: Lane assignment will be given at the meet. One-way sprints at discretion of meet referee.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later

than 25 minutes prior to the start of each session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual

events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet.

Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

TIME TRIALS: Times Trials will be available after <u>session 1</u> – Only 1 event per swimmer. <u>Time Trial fee of \$20.00</u>

cash must be paid at the time of sign up for each session. Details will be available prior to the

meet.

Deadline for time trials will be at the end of the 15 minutes break between events 8 and 9

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.

The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area.

Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for

failure to follow the safety rules.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Medical supervision will be provided by the Boys & Girls Club of Northern Westchester lifeguarding

staff.

WATER DEPTH: USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measur

for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls.'

Deep end: at 1m: 9'0"; at 5m: 7'6" - Shallow end: at 1m: 4'0"; at 5m: 4'6"

AUDIO/VISUAL STATEMENT:

Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, and locker rooms.

The use of cell phones and cameras is prohibited from behind the starting blocks.

"Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present."

DECK CHANGING:

Deck Changes are prohibited.

MAAPP:

All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

ADMISSION:

Free Admission. All spectators are encouraged to use the Meet Mobile App in conjunction with the free Wi-Fi provided by the facility. Electronic Heat Sheets will be made available for free on the Meet Mobile app.

SEATING:

Bleacher seating available for athletes and spectators.

Athletes may also be seated in overflow rooms at hosts discretion.

PARKING:

Parking is available at the Boys & Girls Club and may be available across the street at NW Hospital

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. From I-684 North or South: Take exit 4 to route 172 west (towards Mt. Kisco). Drive approximately 2 miles. Take 117 North (keep right at traffic light). Go one block. Just before the traffic light, turn right into B/G Club driveway. Enter the pool from the main entrance.
- 2. <u>From Long Island</u>: Take Whitestone Bridge, to the Hutchinson Parkway North, to I-684 north, to exit 4 (then proceed as above).
- 3. <u>From Saw Mill Parkway North:</u> Take exit 33, Readers Digest Road. Cross railroad tracks and keep right. At the traffic light, make a left turn on route 117 (it will become Main Street). Pass 2 traffic lights. Just before the third traffic light, turn right into B/G Club driveway.
- 4. From Taconic Parkway South:

Take exit for route 133, Mount Kisco. At the traffic light, make a right turn. At the next traffic light, turn right and follow signs for Mt. Kisco (on route 133 east). Drive approximately 4 miles. At the end of 133, turn right onto route 117 South (Main Street). Pass 2 traffic lights. Just after the third traffic light, make an immediate left turn into the B/G Club driveway.

5. PS: Additional parking may be available across the street in hospital parking lot.

HOTELS:
