- LOCATION:** **FARMINGDALE AQUATIC CENTER – HOWITT MIDDLE SCHOOL POOL, FARMINGDALE**
- FACILITY:** **8 LANE, 25 YARD POOL, CTS6 Timing with Alphanumeric Scoreboard**
The competition course **Has NOT BEEN** certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4).
The Meet Referee reserves the right to run any session in less than 8 lanes.
- SESSIONS:** **Session 1 - 5:00 Pm warm up – 5:45 Pm start**
Session 2 Starts immediately following Session 1, No Warmup or Break Between Sessions
- FORMAT:** **This is a timed-Final Meet.**
The meet will be deck-seeded. Events will be seeded Slow to Fast.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all invited USA swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.
All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.
No Deck Registrations will be accepted
Age on **JUNE 18, 2025** will determine age for the entire meet.
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.
- ENTRIES:** **All Athletes are limited to 3 events per session.**
Host team reserves the right to enter NT for their swimmers.

- DEADLINE:** **Entries must be received by: JUNE 11, 2025**
An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact the Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.
- ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of **\$10.00** per individual event and an athlete surcharge of **\$10.00** must accompany the entries.

Payment must be received **by June 18, 2025** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the Meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.
- WARM-UP:** General warm up with assigned lanes for the first 55 minutes. Starts are during your warmup. Please see the administrative table for lane assignments which will be distributed along with the scratch sheet for each session
- SCRATCHES:** Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES:	In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.
SAFETY:	Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement. All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area. Lifeguards with AED available. Farmingdale FD/EMS Available by 911.
