- SANCTION:** Held under the sanction of USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming, Inc., # **230100**
- LOCATION:** **Purchase College Pool, 735 Anderson Hill Road, Purchase, NY 10577**
- FACILITY:** **Purchase College pool is an indoor 6 lane 25-yard pool.**
Colorado electronic timing system and scoreboard.
The pool has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)
- SESSIONS:** **Session 1: Friday PM - 4:00 PM Warm Up, 5:00 PM Start**
Session 2: Saturday AM – 8:00 AM Warm Up, 9:00 AM Start
Session 3: Saturday PM – 1:30 PM Warm Up, 2:30 PM Start
Session 4: Sunday AM – 8:00 AM Warm Up, 9:00 AM Start
Session 5: Sunday PM – 1:30 PM Warm Up, 2:30 PM Start
- FORMAT:** **This is a timed final meet.**
The meet will be deck seeded.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.
All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.
No “Deck Registrations” will be accepted. **No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless swimmer is a member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules & Regulations Article 302.**
Age on **January 6, 2023** will determine age for the entire meet.
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete’s coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.
- ENTRIES:** **Swimmers may be entered in 4 individual events per session.**
Emailed Hy-Tek entry file is preferred. If sending by mail, entries should be sent on a disk. A Master Sheet must accompany all entries.

- DEADLINE:** The final entry deadline for this meet is December 23, 2022 or until sessions are full. Entries will be accepted on a “first come-first served” basis until a session is full. Once a session is full, no further entries will be accepted for that session.
An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.
- ENTRY FEE:** An entry fee of \$7.00 per individual event plus \$15.00 per athlete facility surcharge must accompany the entries. Make check payable to: **Empire Swimming**. Payment must be received by **December 23, 2022** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.
- Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP:	The host club reserves the right to assign lanes for warm up based on the size of the meet. If lanes are not assigned, the first 30 minutes will be general warm up. The last 10 minutes will have lanes 2 through 5 open for one-way sprints, lanes 1 and 6 for pace, and all other lanes may be assigned at the meet director's discretion. NO diving will be allowed except in designated sprint lanes. All swimmers must be supervised by a coach.
SCRATCHES:	Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.
COACHES:	In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area. DECK PASS LIVE may be used to verify a coach's registration.
AWARDS:	Ribbons will be awarded for 1-6 th place for all 12 & Under age divisions. No awards for 13-14 and Open divisions.

RULES:	The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.
SAFETY:	All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area. Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. "Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water <u>without the use of a backstroke ledge</u>. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement"
MAAPP POLICY:	All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
WATER DEPTH:	USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls." Shallow end (turn end) = 3 feet, 6 inches; Deep end (start end) = 8 feet.

DECK CHANGING: Deck changes are prohibited.

ADMISSION: There **WILL BE SPECTATORS ALLOWED** at this meet. There is no charge for admission to this meet. The meet will also be live streamed, and a link provided on www.empireswimming.com .

MERCHANTS: A limited concession stand will be available throughout the duration of the meet.

PARKING: There is ample parking in the PE Building parking lot # E-6.

DIRECTIONS: **Directions to Purchase College:**

From New York City, Southern Westchester, and Long Island:

Take the Hutchinson River Parkway north to Exit 28 (Lincoln Avenue). Turn Left onto Lincoln Avenue and proceed approximately one mile to Anderson Hill Road (2nd traffic light). Turn right onto Anderson Hill Road. The campus is immediately on the left.

From Northern Westchester:

Take I-684 south to Exit 2 (Route 120), drive over the bridge and turn right onto Route 120 south (Purchase Street). Make the first left onto Route 120 south (Purchase Street). Follow Route 120 south 3.2 miles to Anderson Hill Road (1st traffic light) and turn left. Turn left at 2nd traffic light into campus

From Connecticut:

Take the Merritt Parkway south (which becomes the Hutchinson River Parkway in New York State) south to New York Exit 28, Lincoln Avenue (Note: Do not get off at Exit 28 in Connecticut). Turn right onto Lincoln Avenue and proceed approximately one mile to Anderson Hill Road (2nd traffic light). Turn right onto Anderson Hill Road. The campus is immediately on the left.

Directions to the Gymnasium at Purchase College:

When you enter the Campus from Anderson Hill Road, bear right. The Physical Education building is the first building on the right (approx. 1 mile in) and 1/10 of a mile past the building is the driveway for the "E6/E7/E8" parking lot on the right (It is across from E-5 parking). Park in any legal space (E6) or in the gravel lot (E7) next to the lower Tennis courts (Most of the spaces are there). You will enter the building at the basement level so just come up to the first floor. The pool is to the right of the large windows that face the parking lot. 1021-A is the pool office.
