An entry fee of \$10.00 per individual event must accompany the entries. Athlete Surcharge \$5.00

Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries

WARM-UP:

General warm-up with assigned lanes for the first 30 minutes. Sprint lanes and general lanes will be available for the remaining 15 minutes. Lane assignments will be distributed along with the scratch sheet for each session.

SCRATCHES:

Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES:

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

RULES:

The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY:

Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

"Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement"

Lifeguards will be available to athletes participating in the meet.

Water DEPTH:

USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured for a distance of 3 feet 3 1/2 inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."

Shallow End: 1.0 Meter = 3'10" 5.0 Meters = 4'1" Deep End: 1.0 meter = 12'7" 5.0 Meters= 11'10"

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4)

Once in the parking lot the pool is located to the far left, next to the Football field. From the NYS Thruway South exit at Route 84 West. Follow Route 84 West to Exit 3W to Route 17M Middletown. From Route 17M turn left on Route 6. Follow Route 6 for four miles through Slate Hill. Minisink Valley High School is just past S Slate Hill on your left. Turn left into the Main District facility and follow entrance road down to the High School which is on the left. Once in the parking lot the pool is located to the far left, next to the Football field. From Route 84 take Exit 3W to Route 17M Middletown. From Route 17M turn left on Route 6.
