WARM-UP: General warm up, no assigned lanes except for sprints.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than

30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual event

scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

Deck Changes: Deck changes are prohibited.

TIME TRIALS: Not available COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid

USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area. Coaches bathroom is located in

the Lifeguard office on the pool deck or the Adult Locker room.

AWARDS: 12 & under medals and ribbons. Individual events - medals 1-3, ribbons 4-6, Relays - ribbons 1-3

All age groups – 1st, 2nd, 3rd, fastest combined time in all 5 events awards.

DIRECTOR: MAAPP Policy:

All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

RULES &

Policy:

The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee. The YMCA is a smoke free facility. No food or glass of any kind permitted in pool area or balcony. Any photographer or videographer, who intends to take pictures at a Metropolitan Swimming sanctioned meet, must complete and submit a Photographer Registration form to the Meet Director before commencing activity. Forms are available on the Metro Swimming web site as well as from the Meet Director. "Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present."

SAFETY: Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet.

Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the

safety rules.

"Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the

backstroke ledge.

When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal

guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement."

There will be lifeguards on duty for the duration of the meet. There is an AED device available at the

front entrance of the YMCA and there are emergency alarms on the pool deck.

All swimmers must wear footwear when leaving the pool deck to sit in the balcony or go to the locker

rooms. They must wear footwear when leaving the balcony to go down on the pool deck.

DEPTH:

WATER

Diving end water depth – 12 feet at 1 meter, 8 feet at 15 meters Shallow end water depth – 4 feet at 1 meter, 10 feet at 15 meters

\$5 for 18 and over. Once the balcony has reached capacity additional spectators may view meet via TV screen in 2nd floor lobby. No standing behind glass partitions. Programs will be available for purchase

OR THE MUNICIPAL LOT ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE REAR ENTRANCE TO THE Y

Supervision:

Each club is requested to handle its own team and discipline problems. Anyone found guilty of vandalism or disorderly conduct will be ejected from the meet. No one is permitted above the 2nd floor of the YMCA.

Coaches must show their current U.S.A. membership card to pick up meet packet. Only currently certified Coaches are allowed on deck. Swimmers are not allowed to use adult lock rooms without permission.

Spectators/Swimmers/Coaches: Spectator seating will be provided in the balcony. When capacity is reached, additional spectators may view meet via TV in the main lobby.

<u>Swimmers will be seated on deck and in the pool balcony.</u> Pool deck will include swimmers, timers, coaches, marshals and lifeguards. No smoking allowed in the building.

Swimmers in the meet will be seated on deck. Additional swimmers will be seated in the pool balcony. We will be following NYC DOH, US Swimming and YMCA Covid guidelines. Spectators will NOT be allowed to stand behind the glass partitions outside of the pool balcony. Any spillover will be in the main lobby with a TV monitor that will have a live feed from the pool balcony. Additional parents will be on deck timing, officiating and marshaling.
