No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

2: The final entry deadline for this meet is **February 1, 2023**

3: Metro entries received between **January 1** and **February 1, 2023** and all entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

ENTRY FEE:

An entry fee of \$8.00 per individual event must accompany the entries. There will be a \$10.00 Facility surcharge for each athlete Make check payable to: **Long Island Express LTD**. Payment must be received by **February 10, 2023** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

WARM-UP

General warm-up will be in place.

SCRATCHES

Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon arrival. Scratches are due 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. NO DECK ENTRIES ALLOWED.

COACHES

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

Deep end water depth - 15 feet at 1 meter, 12 feet at 5 meters
Shallow end water depth – 4 feet at 1 meter, 7 feet at 5 meters

RULES

The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. **The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.**
The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event." Is required.

SAFETY

Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

DRONES	Operation of a drone or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
ADMISSION	\$5.00 per person
DECK CHANGES	Deck changing is prohibited !!
MERCHANTS	No food or beverages will be served by host team. A merchandise concession will be available by outside vendor.
PARKING	Free parking on campus.
DIRECTIONS	Meadowbrook Parkway to exit M4, (route 24 west) Hempstead Turnpike West to Dunkin Donuts. Turn right on to entrance of campus. Go to second stop sign and turn right. Go to past field to first stop sign. Swim Center will be on the right.
AUDIO	Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms or behind the blocks. - Art. - 202.3 and 202.4
