FORMAT: This is a timed final meet. The meet will be deck seeded.

This is a Metro Championship meet for Metro Central Teams only. Entries must comply with 2023

Silvers Championships time standards. All entries must be received by the meet deadline.

Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer

will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

Deck registrations will **NOT** be accepted

Age on February 24, 2023 will determine age for the entire meet.

ADDITIONAL ELIGIBILITY As voted on at the BOD of February 28, 2013: If a swimmer ages up to a new ELIGIBILITY age group between the first day of Silvers (February 24, 2023) and the first day of MRAG's (March 10, 2023), and that swimmer has a MRAG qualifying time in the age group they are entered during Silvers (making that swimmer ineligible to swim at Silvers), but that swimmer does not have a MRAG qualifying time in that same event in the new age group by the meet extension deadline of MRAG's that swimmer would be able to swim that event as exhibition/nonaward at Silvers

Entries for that swimmer should be clicked as X (exhibition) in Team Manager/Team Unify. In addition, the name of the swimmers involved in this new rule should be clearly added in the text of the Silvers entries.

Time Trials will ONLY be run if time allows and at the discretion of the Meet Referee and Meet Director. There will be no more than two (2) time trials per swimmer over the course of the meet

and any time trial will count towards the 5 events per day/per swimmer limit.

The cost is \$10 per time trial and must be paid in cash at the meet.

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible

for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

Swimmers may be entered in a maximum of 2 individual events for the Friday night

session, 5 maximum individual events for each of the Saturday and Sunday sessions

There will be age group events for 9&Under, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15-18.

Times have to be achieved between January 1, 2022 and the entry deadline, February 15,

2023.

A SWIMS Times Recon will be done at least one week prior to the meet. Times must have been achieved within the qualifying period and must be in the SWIMS database. Entry times

An email confirming receipt of entries if you provide an email contact. Please contact the Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

New Silver cuts achieved from February 15, 2023 through February 23, 2023 will be accepted if provable in SWIMS. No updates of times are possible.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$7.50 per individual event, \$1 per swimmer Metropolitan Swimming surcharge, and

\$4 per swimmer facility surcharge must accompany the entries.

Make check payable to: NCAC.

Payment must be received by February 15, 2023 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the Meet Director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP: Warm-ups will be run under Metro Swimming Warm-up and Safety Guidelines. Warm-ups

will be assigned, each team will get assigned lanes and time. One way sprint lanes must be monitored by the swimmers' coach. All swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end

of the pool. One way sprint lanes will open 20 minutes before the end of warm-ups.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no

later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Medals are awarded for places 1-3, ribbons for places 4-8.

Awarded to 9&U, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14-18 age groups.

Awards must be picked up by a coach during the meet. Any award not picked up will NOT be

mailed.

Swimmers that qualify for Metro Age Group Champs (MRAG, formerly JOs) do not receive

awards but may enter MRAG, even if the MRAG deadline has passed.

RULES: Only USA Swimming and Metropolitan Swimming certified coaches' questions will be entertained.

All parents are to speak with their individual team's coaches regarding specific needs.

The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the Meet Referee.

SAFETY:

All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area. Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Emergency Assistance: Lifeguards will be stationed at the competition and at the warm-up pools. The life guard office and first aid station is located near the deep end of the pool.

MAAPP POLICY:
