FORMAT: Timed Finals seeding slowest to fastest

Metro LSC scratch rules will be in effect

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No deck

registrations will be accepted.

Age on **December 17, 2022** will determine age for the entire meet.

"No Time" or NT entries are accepted

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302

of the USA Swimming Rulebook

DISABILITYSwimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the Meet Director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the Meet Referee

of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: Swimmers can enter up to 4 individual events plus one relay per session

Entries will be accepted on first-come, first-serve basis and may be limited based on both session

time and covid capacity constraints

ENTRY FEE: Entry fee of \$6.00 per individual event, \$12.00 per relay entry, plus a \$5.00 athlete surcharge

Payment must be received by December 15, 2022 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the Meet Director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP: Assigned Warm-up procedures will be in effect

SCRATCHES: Scratch sheets will be provided to coaches upon check-in, and must be returned to the meet desk 45

minutes before the start of the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

> valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

> The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area. Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up

> procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the Meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure

compliance with this requirement.

MAAPP POLICY: All adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the

provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this

competition.

DECK CHANGING: Deck changes are prohibited.

PARKING: There is ample free parking at the high school. Please adhere to all indicated parking regulations

DIRECTIONS: From East/West; Take I-84 to exit 5 (Maybrook). Get off at exit 5 and turn onto route 208 north.

Proceed about 1.2 miles and turn left onto Route 17K West. Once on 17K, proceed about 1.0 mile

to Valley Central High School on the left. (1175 RT-17K Montgomery, NY 12549).
