FORMAT: All events will be swum as timed finals. Deck seeded with Scratch Sheets collected 60

minutes prior to the start of events.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer

will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

No Deck Registrations will be accepted.

Age on **December 16, 2023** will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible

for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: All athletes are limited to entering 5 individual events plus one relay event per session. NO TIME

entries will be accepted, except for distance events. Entries will not be considered received and

accepted without full payment of fees.

ENTRY FEE: An entry fee of \$10 per individual event, \$20 per relay, and \$5 per swimmer facility surcharge must

accompany the entries.

Payment must be received by **December 16**, **2023** for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the

meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the Meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish

considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP: The host team will assign warm up lanes and time slots to each team for each session. That

information will be distributed a few days prior to the meet. Starts can be done at the

discretion of the coach during their assigned warm-up. All swimmers must be supervised by

a coach during warm-ups.

TIMERS: Host team will provide timers. Swimmers in the 500F must provide their own counters.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later

than 45 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual

event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

> valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Awards for 12 & under individual events for top 8 places will be given

The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. **RULES:**

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. SAFETY:

> Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the

safety rules.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the

swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Lifeguard(s) will be posted on the pool deck during all warm-ups and meet sessions.

AED is located on the pool deck.

MAAPP POLICY: All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the

provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this

competition.

WATER DEPTH: USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured

for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."

Depth of Pool at One (1) Meter 10'8" and Five (5) Meters 9'9" from Start End of Pool. Depth of Pool at One (1) Meter 3' 4" and Five (5) Meters 4' 0" from Turn End of Pool.

Use of Audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms. No photography or visual recordings are permitted from behind the starting blocks. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches,

officials and/or spectators are present.

DECK CHANGING: Deck changes are prohibited.
