- LOCATION** Lehman College pool, Lehman College, 250 Bedford Park Blvd West, Bronx NY 10468
- FACILITY** Lehman College is an 8 lane 50 meter pool The meet will be run in the DakTronics electronic timing system and an 8-line scoreboard.

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4).”
- SESSIONS** **Session 1: Sunday 1:00 PM Warm Up, 2:00 PM Start**
Time trial available at the end of the session. \$10.00 each, Cash.

Afternoon session warm-up and start times may be adjusted after the meet entries deadline. All teams will be notified.
- FORMAT** This is a LCM meet. Timed finals format. No Deck entries allowed. The meet will be deck seeded. See scratch procedure below.
- ELIGIBILITY** Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers. All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. Age on May 7th 2023 will determine age for the entire meet.

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

No Deck Registrations will be accepted
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete’s coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

ENTRIES: All athletes are limited to enter a maximum of 4 events for this session.

Coaches should contact the Meet Director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP: Warm Up Lanes will be Assigned.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session.

All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual event scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.

The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet referee.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement. Lifeguards, AED device available to athletes participating in the meet.

BY BUS: FROM WESTCHESTER: (White Plains, Hartsdale, Scarsdale, Yonkers via Central

Park Ave.) #20 or #20X or (Yonkers via Getty Square/South Broadway/McClean Ave./Central Park Ave.) #4 to Bedford Park Blvd. Terminus and walk West.
