- FACILITY:** 25-yard pool with 8-foot lanes and non-turbulent lane lines. Colorado electronic timing system and a 1-line scoreboard in use. The pool has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4)
- SESSIONS:** 1- Saturday, Warm up 8:00am
2-Sunday, Warm up 8:00am
A 15-minute warm up will built into the meet prior to the 800 & 1650 Freestyle events
- FORMAT:** This will be a timed finals event.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.
All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet.
"Deck Registrations" will NOT be accepted
Age on 10/01/22 will determine age for the entire meet.
- DISABILITY SWIMMERS:** Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to attend. Contact the meet director if you need special consideration. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.
- ENTRIES:** Swimmers may be entered in 2 events on Saturday and Sunday.

Emailed Hy-Tek entry file is preferred. If sending by mail, entries should be sent on disk. A Master Sheet must accompany all entries.

- DEADLINE:** 1: Metro LSC teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams' entries must be received by 09/23/22

Entries from other LSC's will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows.

An email confirming receipt of entries will be sent if you provide an email contact. Please contact the Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

ENTRY FEE:

An entry fee of \$10 per individual event, and a \$5 swimmer surcharge must accompany the entries. Make check payable to: NYSA GOSHEN

Payment must be received by 10/01/22 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the meet.

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers.

Coaches should contact meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

WARM-UP:

The meet director reserves the right to assign warm-up lanes and sessions. Each lane, in each session, can initiate one-way sprints at their discretion.

SCRATCHES:

Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the session. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual events scratches and which swimmers will not be participating in the session.

COACHES:

In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

COVID PROTOCOL:

AWARDS:

Ribbons will be awarded to 14 & under swimmers only for places 1st – 8th in all events.

RULES:

The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet.

The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY:

All swimmers must wear footwear upon leaving the pool area. Metropolitan Safety and Warm-up procedures will be in effect. Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the safety rules. **“Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer’s legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement”**

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- MAAPP POLICY:** All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- WATER DEPTH:** Start End 1 Meter 6'; 5 meters 5.5'
Turn End 1 Meter 4'; 5 meters 5'
- DISCLAIMER:** Upon acceptance of his/her entries, the participant waives all claims against the Goshen Sports Complex, Goshen Aquatic Center, NYS Aquatics, Inc., New York Sharks Aquatics Goshen Incorporated, Metropolitan Swimming Inc., USA Swimming Inc., their agents or representatives for any injury occurring as a result of the meet. "It is understood that USA Swimming, Inc. and Metropolitan Swimming, Inc. shall be free from liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event."

- DECK CHANGING:** Deck changes are prohibited.
- ADMISSION:** There is NO spectator seating at GAC. All spectators are encouraged to use the Meet Mobile App in conjunction with the free wifi provided by the facility to view heat sheets and the live feed provided. Electronic Heat Sheets will be made available for free on the Meet Mobile app.
- MERCHANTS:** No merchants will be available at this event.
- PARKING:** There is ample on-site parking next to the pool. All families must park in the lot to avoid ticketing or towing.
Attendees should NOT park on the grass on any residential streets, or they will be towed by the town.
