LOCATION: James McCann Center, Marist College, Poughkeepsie, NY 12601

FACILITY: The James McCann Natatorium is a six lane 25yd competition pool with separate diving well.

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C (4).

SESSIONS: Friday afternoon session 1: Warm-up 2:00 pm. start 2:30 pm.

Friday evening session 2: Warm-up 4 pm, start 5 pm.

Saturday & Sunday sessions 3 & 5: Warm-up 7:30 am, start 9 am. Saturday & Sunday sessions 4 & 6: Warm-up 1 pm, start 2:30 pm.

Session warm-up/start times subject to change at discretion of Meet Director and Meet

FORMAT: All events will be swum as timed finals. Deck seeded with Scratch Sheets collected 60

minutes prior to the start of Saturday and Sunday sessions, and 45 minutes before the start of Session 2. Session 1 (Boys and Girls Open 1000 Free) will be limited to 6 heats (fastest to slowest alternative girls/boys; scratches for 1000F are due 24 hours before the session so there is time to fill open lanes with any swimmers that were dropped due to the heat limit.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Invited USA Swimming/Metropolitan Swimming Inc. registered swimmers.

All swimmers participating in this meet must be registered by the first day of the meet. No swimmer

will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

No Deck Registrations will be accepted.

Age on October 20, 2023 will determine age for the entire meet.

DISABILITY Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to enter and participate. Please notify the meet director **SWIMMERS:** of any accommodations you might require. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible

for notifying the meet referee of any disability prior to the competition.

All athletes are limited to enter 3 events Friday and 5 individual events per day on Saturday and

Sunday. NO TIME entries will be accepted, except for distance events. 1000 Freestyle events will be limited to 6 total heats. Receipt of entries will be confirmed by email. DEADLINE: 1: Invited teams will be given priority on a first come/first served basis. Metro teams entries must be

received by September 20, 2023 to be given priority

2: The final entry deadline for this meet is October 13, 2023

3: Metro entries received between September 20, 2023 and October 13, 2023 and all entries from other LSC's during that time period will be entered in the order they were received, as space allows. 4: An email confirming receipt of entries will be sent when the entries are processed. Please contact

Meet Director if you do not receive such a report within 2 days of your original email.

An entry fee of \$8 per individual event, \$16 per relay, and \$7 per swimmer must accompany the

entries. Make check payable to: RED FOX AQUATICS.

Payment must be received by October 13, 2023 for email entries. Payment must be included with all mail entries. Failure to pay entry fees by this deadline could result in teams being barred from the

Host Club may waive meet entry fees & facility surcharge for registered outreach swimmers. Coaches should contact the Meet director and identify registered swimmers whom they wish considered for waiver of fees when submitting meet entries.

ENTRIES:

ENTRY FEE:

WARM-UP: The host team will assign warm up lanes and time slots to each team for each session. That

information will be distributed a few days prior to the meet. Starts can be done at the discretion of the coach during their assigned warm-up. All swimmers must be supervised by

a coach during warm-ups.

TIMERS: Swimmers in the 1000Free event (Session 1) will need to provide their own timer AND counter.

Swimmers in the 500Free event (Session 2) will need to provide their own counter.

SCRATCHES: Coaches will be given scratch sheets upon check-in for each session. All scratches are due no later

than 60 minutes prior to the start of Saturday and Sunday sessions. Session 2 scratches are due 45 minutes before the start of the session, and Session 1 scratches are due 24 hours in advance. Coaches are asked to indicate clearly individual event scratches and which swimmers will not be

participating in the session.

COACHES: In accordance with Metropolitan Swimming Inc. Policy, only those coaches who display current,

valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches who do not possess these credentials will be required to leave the deck area.

AWARDS: Individual Awards will be given for 1st 6 places for all 8 & under, 9-10, and 11-12 individual

events, and for 1st 3 places in 8 & under, 9-10, and 11-12 relays

RULES: The current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply.

The USA Swimming Code of Conduct is in effect for the duration of the meet. The overhead start procedure may be used at the discretion of the meet Referee.

SAFETY: Metropolitan Swimming Safety Guidelines and Warm-up Procedures will be in effect at this meet.

Marshals will be present throughout warm-ups and competition, and have the authority to remove, with the concurrence of the meet Referee, any swimmer, coach, club, or spectator for failure to follow the

safety rules.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer, or the swimmer's legal guardian, to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Lifeguard(s) will be posted on the pool deck during all warm-ups and meet sessions.

AED is located in the adjacent hallway near the public restrooms.

MAAPP POLICY: All adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the

provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with MAAPP is a condition of participation in the conduct of this

competition.

WATER DEPTH: USA 2011 - 202.3.7 "The meet announcement shall include information about water depth measured

for a distance of 3 feet 3½ inches (1.0 meter) to 16 feet 5 inches (5.0 meters) from both end walls."

The competition pool ranges from 5.5ft. at the start end to 4.0ft. at the turn end.
